NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic regulation Orders under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

The first Order prohibits driving on Montague Place in Worthing from a point 22 metres north of its junction with Marine Parade, northwards to its junction with Montague Street.

The second Order introduces 3 parking bays for loading/unloading for any vehicle at any time on the eastern side of Montague Place immediately north of its junction with Marine Parade and prohibits waiting/loading/unloading at any time on all remaining lengths of Montague Place. This Order also permanently converts the existing parking bays on the northern side of Marine Parade outside Marks & Spencers, to bays reserved for disabled persons' blue badge holders at any time.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the West Sussex County Council website. The <u>website</u> includes a response form for any comments or objections.

Due to current social distancing requirements, paper copies of documents will not be available to view in council offices or libraries. Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic Regulation Orders as follows:

The first Order prohibits driving on Montague Place in Worthing from a point 22 metres north of its junction with Marine Parade, northwards to its junction with Montague Street.

The second Order introduces 3 parking bays for loading/unloading for any vehicle at any time on the eastern side of Montague Place immediately north of its junction with Marine Parade and prohibits waiting/loading/unloading at any time on all remaining lengths of Montague Place. This Order also permanently converts the existing parking bays on the northern side of Marine Parade outside Marks & Spencers, to bays reserved for disabled persons' blue badge holders at any time.

The effect of these Orders will be to pedestrianize Montague Place throughout most of its length, while retaining access to the Beaulieu Court parking area and retaining loading/unloading access for businesses in Montague Place. The scheme is part of a package of town centre improvement works being managed by Worthing Borough Council.

The permanent parking Order for Montague Place presently provides parking places for disabled persons' blue badge holders along the eastern side of the road. During the current temporary closure of Montague Place to aid social distancing, this parking has been relocated to the bays on Marine Parade outside Marks and Spencers. It is proposed to make this arrangement permanent to ensure parking for disabled drivers is retained when Montague Place is permanently pedestrianized.

The new orders are therefore proposed to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the affected roads run.

The attached drawing, titled Montague Place General Arrangement shows the proposed layout of the road after the proposed prohibition of driving order is enacted. Drawing number TQ1402SEN shows the proposed new parking restrictions as they will appear in the proposed parking Order.

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2), 4 (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the ** day of ****** 2022 and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Worthing: Montague Place) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2022" hereinafter called "this Order".
- 2. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under an enactment.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle of pedal cycle to proceed on the length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply in respect of a motor vehicle or pedal cycle:-
 - (a) under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform; or
 - (b) being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in the event of an emergency.


