NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make Orders under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:-

- (i) extend the existing prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading in East Street to apply between the hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm, seven days a week; and
- (ii) introduce a prohibition of waiting loading and unloading at any time at the junction of East Street and Park Place; and
- (iii) introduce a prohibition of waiting loading and unloading between the hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm, seven days a week in Park Place; and
- (iv) permit loading and unloading between the hours of 10.30pm and 10.30am by any vehicle in the 3 designated loading bays in East Street; and
- (v) extend the prohibition of driving in East Street and Market Square between the hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm seven days a week. Motor vehicles will only be permitted to travel north-westwards in East Street at other times. Access for pedal cycles will be unaffected; and
- (vi) introduce a prohibition of driving in Park Place between the hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm. Access for pedal cycles will be unaffected.

The consultations for these proposals will start on 12 May 2022 and, AT THAT TIME, full details of the proposals in this Notice can be viewed on our website www.westsussex.gov.uk/tro. The website includes a response form for comments or objections.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDERS

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make Orders the effect of which will be to:-

- extend the existing prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading in East Street (i) to apply between the hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm, seven days a week; and
- (ii) introduce a prohibition of waiting loading and unloading at any time at the junction of East Street and Park Place; and
- introduce a prohibition of waiting loading and unloading between the hours of (iii) 10.30am and 10.30pm, seven days a week in Park Place; and
- permit loading and unloading between the hours of 10.30pm and 10.30am by (iv) any vehicle in the 3 designated loading bays in East Street; and
- extend the prohibition of driving in East Street and Market Square between the (v) hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm seven days a week. Motor vehicles will only be permitted to travel north-westwards in East Street at other times. Access for pedal cycles will be unaffected; and
- introduce a prohibition of driving in Park Place between the hours of 10.30am (vi) and 10.30pm. Access for pedal cycles will be unaffected.

In 2013 a scheme of traffic regulation was introduced in East Street to facilitate the shared space improvements scheme that had been designed to reduce through traffic and encourage greater emphasis on pedestrian use and support the creation of a café culture.

East Street has been subject to a prohibition of driving between the hours of 10.30am and 4.30pm daily. Outside of these hours East Street remained available for use by vehicles loading and unloading and blue badge holders only.

Under the COVID 19 Reopening High Streets Safely Scheme, in August 2020 the core time hours were extended until 10.30pm. This provided a safer street for pedestrians and cyclists whilst supporting the economy by creating evening outdoor eating areas. The traffic free streets improve air quality and lower noise levels whilst supporting the viability of cafes and restaurants.

Building on the success of the Reopening High Streets Safely Scheme in Horsham it is proposed to introduce a prohibition of driving and a prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading between the hours of 10.30am and 10.30pm daily in East Street and in Park Place. Outside of these hours loading and unloading would be permitted in East Street in the 3 designated loading bays.

The Orders are proposed for facilitating the safe passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2) and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

PART I GENERAL Commencement and Citation

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the X day of X 202* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Horsham: East Street, Market Square & Park Place) (Traffic Regulation) Order 202*."
- 2. The parts of the Order specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

Interpretation

3. (1) In this Order:-

"blue badge" and "disabled persons badge" have the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations SI 682;

"Council" means either or both District Council and/or the County Council;

"County Council" means West Sussex County Council;

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"District Council" means Horsham District Council;

"pedal cycle" means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels not being in any case a motor cycle;

"vehicle" has the same meaning as that assigned to "motor vehicle" in section 136(1) of the Act.

(2) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

PART II PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PROVISIONS

- 4. Save as provided in Articles 7, 8, 9 and 10, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road at any time.

- 6. Nothing in Article 5 shall apply to a pedal cycle.
- 7. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply in respect of a vehicle being used:-
 - (a) for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in the event of an emergency; or
 - (b) with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (c) (with the prior permission of the Council) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal on or near the said roads of any sewer pipe conduit wire cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas water electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 resulting from works or an emergency; or
 - (d) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of its statutory powers or duties; or
 - (e) in association with an event for which a road closure order under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has been made by Horsham District Council; or
- 8. Nothing in Article 4 shall apply in respect of a vehicle being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the lengths of roads in the Second Schedule to this Order between the hours of 10.30pm and 10.30am.
- 9. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply in respect of a vehicle validly displaying a Blue Badge between the hours of 10.30pm and 10.30am.
- 10. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply in respect of a vehicle being used (with the prior permission of the Council) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the lengths of roads in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 11. If it appears to the County Council essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or the provision of suitable adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, they may after
 - (a) consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, and
 - (b) giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct,

make modifications or suspend the Order or any provision contained therein.






PAGE 1 OF 2: EXISTING RESTRICTIONS ONLY
