#### STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDERS

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to introduce permanent Orders the effects of which will be to:

- (i) permit pedal cyclists to travel southbound on Barrington Road; and
- (ii) introduce a length of prohibiton of waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on the eastern side of Barrington Road adjacent to Nos. 34-36; and
- (iii) remove a length of double yellow lines adjacent to Nos. 4-6 replacing it with residents parking bays.

Improvements to cycling routes in Horsham Town Centre are being promoted by West Sussex County Council as part of the programme of Local Transport Improvements.

There is a one-way system operating northbound in Barrington Road.

The proposed measures are intended to give cyclists more route options and enable them to choose quieter, less trafficked, routes. This aims to help promote cycling with the corresponding benefits for reducing motor traffic and road congestion, improving air quality and personal health and fitness.

Currently southbound cycle traffic is expected to use Station Road. Forest Neighbourhood Council and the Horsham Cycle Forum have identified a 'missing link' in the cycle infrastructure which would allow safer access route to New Street and tying together other named cycle routes.

The proposal will permit use of a southbound contra-flow cycle route on Barrington Road.

It has been noted that some cycle traffic already uses this route informally. This scheme seeks to legitimise this use whilst alerting the oncoming traffic to the possibility of encountering a cyclist, thereby promoting a safer usage and environment.

Although on-street parking capacity will not be reduced residents parking bays adjacent to Nos. 34-36 will be replaced with a length of double yellow lines with the parking bays being relocated adjacent to Nos. 4-6. This is because although traffic density and speeds are low the road is narrow. The double yellow lines will create a centrally located refuge and the route into the contraflow will be tapered.

This Order is proposed so as to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Drawing 70090305-WSP-HGN-BAR-DR-CH-0100 and Plan TQ1830NWN shows the length of road, which are the subject of the proposed Orders.

#### WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (HORSHAM: BARRINGTON ROAD) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2) and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

## PART I GENERAL Commencement and Citation

- This Order shall come into operation on the X day of X 2022 and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Horsham: Barrington Road) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2022."
- 2. The Order specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.

#### **Interpretation**

- 3. (1) In this Order:
  - "Council" means either/both District Council or/and County Council;
  - "County Council" means West Sussex County Council;
  - "District Council" means Horsham District Council;
  - "pedal cycle" means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels not being in any case a motor cycle;
  - "vehicle" has the same meaning as that assigned to "motor vehicle" in section 136(1) of the Act.
  - (2) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

## PART II ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PROVISIONS

- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5, and 6 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road at any time.
- 5. Nothing in Article 4 shall apply to a pedal cycle
- 6. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply in respect of a vehicle being used:
  - (a) for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in the event of an emergency; or
  - (b) with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform;or
  - (c) (with the prior permission of the Council) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal on or near

the said roads of any sewer pipe conduit wire cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas water electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 resulting from works or an emergency; or

- (d) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of its statutory powers or duties; or
- (e) in association with an event for which a road closure order under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has been made by Horsham District Council.
- 6. If it appears to the County Council essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or the provision of suitable adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, they may after
  - (a) consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, and
  - (b) giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct,

make modifications or suspend the Order or any provision contained therein.








## PAGE 1 OF 2: EXISTING RESTRICTIONS ONLY
