
## West Sussex County Council (Worth: Public Footpaths 49W and 50W) (Temporary Closure) Order 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily close Public Footpath 49W and 50W in Worth at Furnace Wood (the route along the northern side of Furnace Pond), from its junction with Public Footpath 43W, eastwards to its junction with Public Footpath 46W.

The closure of this route is needed to maintain public safety due to the unsafe condition of a footbridge on the affected route. The Order extends the operation of a current emergency closure notice and will come into effect on 20 December 2022. Once made, the Order may remain in force for up to 6 months, or until the footpath is repaired, whichever is earlier.

Unfortunately, during the operative period of this Order, no direct alternative route is available via the public rights of way network. Any queries about the effect of the Order should be directed to the West Sussex County Council Public Rights of Way Team, telephone number 01243 777620.
