NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the northern side of Maytree Avenue in Worthing, from its junction with the A24, eastwards for a distance of approximately 20m.

(Maytree Avenue Amendment) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will install double yellow lines on the northern side of Maytree Avenue in Worthing, from its junction with the A24, eastwards for a distance of approximately 20m.

The footway on the eastern side of the A24 in Worthing has recently been upgraded to become a shared-use cycle route. To accommodate the new route dropped kerbs have been installed at junctions on the eastern side of the A24. At Maytree Avenue, vehicles are frequently observed parking close to the junction of the A24. The presence of parked vehicles at this location unacceptably limits the vision of cyclists when crossing Maytree Avenue and may lead to obstruction of the crossing point.

The new restriction will maintain safe access to the cycle route and prevent vehicles parking too close to a junction at a location considered hazardous to vehicular traffic entering Maytree Avenue.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected length of road.

The attached drawing, numbered TQ1207NES shows the length of road affected by the proposed order.


