NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the south side of Lyndhurst Road in Worthing, at the entrance to new property development being constructed near the junction of Lyndhurst Road with Farncombe Road.

The new restriction described above replaces part of an existing parking bay for residents/visitors permit holders. To replace the parking lost by the above restriction the western end of the affected parking bay on Lyndhurst Road will be extended. In addition, a length of single yellow line on the eastern side of Farncombe Road outside the new development site will be removed and replaced by an extended residents/visitor parking bay.

(Lyndhurst Road and Farncombe Road Amendment) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the south side of Lyndhurst Road in Worthing, at the entrance to new property development being constructed near the junction of Lyndhurst Road with Farncombe Road.

The new restriction described above replaces part of an existing parking bay for residents/visitors permit holders. To replace the parking lost by the above restriction the western end of the affected parking bay on Lyndhurst Road will be extended. In addition, a length of single yellow line on the eastern side of Farncombe Road outside the new development site will be removed and replaced by an extended residents/visitor parking bay.

A new residential property development is being constructed on land located at the corner of Lyndhurst Road and Farncombe Road. This development will have a parking area accessed from Lyndhurst Road and the new double yellow lines are needed to provide safe access.

The extensions to residents/visitor permit holders' parking bays on Lyndhurst Road and Farncombe Road will ensure that the amount of parking available to residents in the area is maintained.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to preserve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached drawing, numbered TQ1503SES shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.


