STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to introduce a permanent Order the effect of which will be to extend the lengths of prohibition of waiting at all times (double yellow lines) on Godstalls Lane, Steyning south of the junction with Newham Lane southwards by 10 metres on the east side and by 108 metres on the west side.

Godstalls Lane is a narrow cul-de-sac south of Newham Road that leads to Perrots Lane. Refuse vehicles routinely have to mount the kerb and verges to avoid parked vehicles and delivery vehicles have refused to enter the road due to the narrow access. An application was made to the County Council for a Community Highways Scheme to resolve these issues.

The proposed scheme will improve access to Godstalls Lane by widening the bellmouth junction and carriageway and reducing the verge width.

The scheme also looks to improve the pedestrian crossing facilities. The existing double yellow lines will be extended southwards to protect the junction and to facilitate vehicular movement throughout the lane without fully restricting parking on-street.

This Order is proposed to avoid danger to persons or traffic using the road or for preventing such danger from arising and to facilitate the safe passage of traffic, for preventing damage to the road and for facilitating passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)






PAGE 1 OF 2: EXISTING RESTRICTIONS ONLY
