General

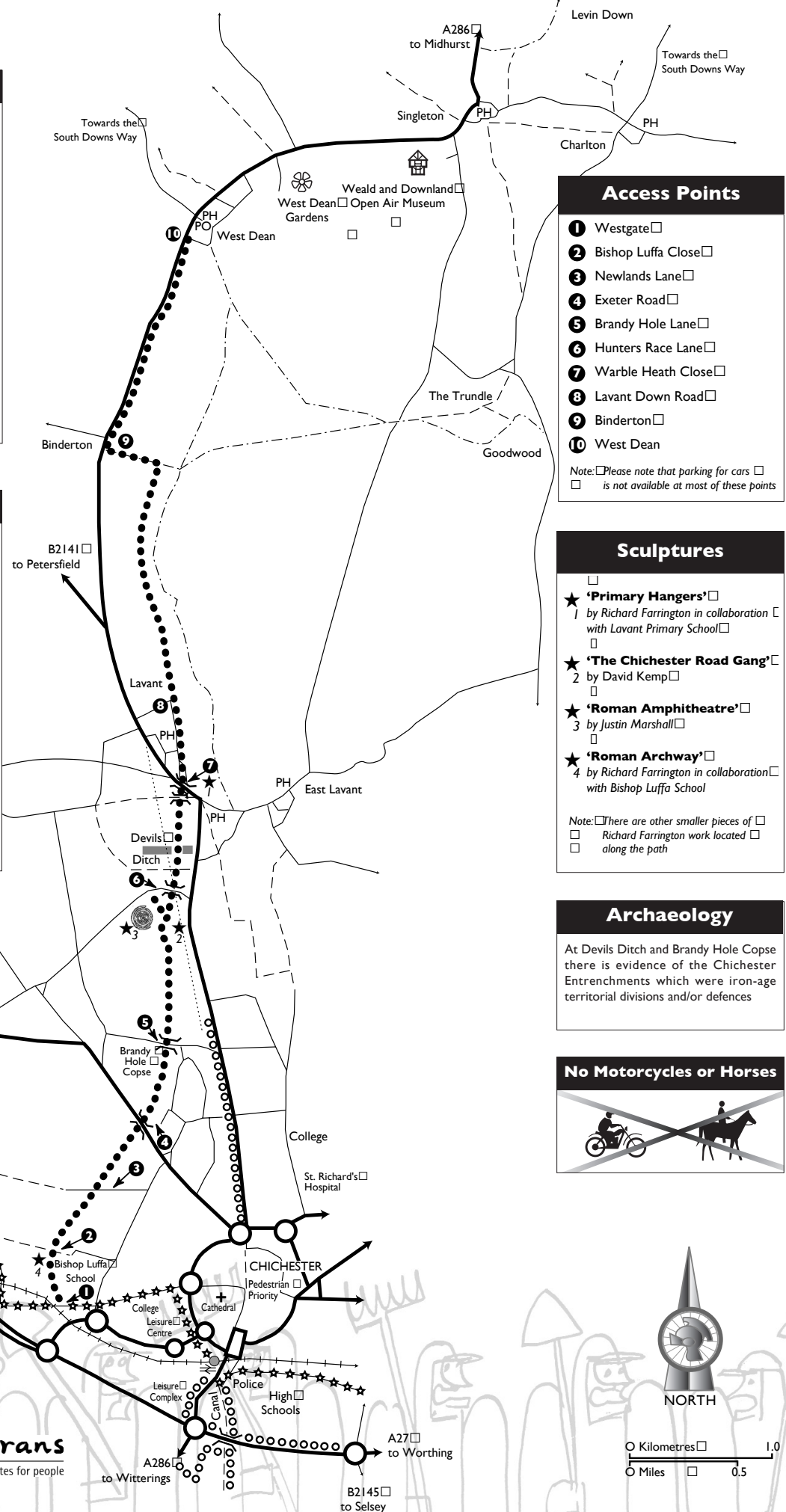
- Please do not drop litter
