## **Full-time Teacher of Geography TMS**

We require a self-motivated, talented and innovative teacher of Geography to join the Geography subject team in the Humanities Curriculum Area. We are a dynamic curriculum area in a school renowned for academic excellence.

The Humanities Curriculum Area consists of Geography, History, Religious Education and PSHCE. The Humanities CA is a vibrant and self-motivated group of teachers and support staff. Within the CA there are 15 full time teachers which includes a Director of Learning who leads the CA, supported by 4 Assistant Directors of Learning including one with subject responsibility for Geography.

The Humanities CA has a suite of rooms including 13 classrooms all of which have projectors and Smartboards. There is also a Humanities office and resource room in which ICT facilities are available. The team has a strong vision and is dedicated to developing all subjects within our area and enabling our students to leave the school with an awareness of their moral, spiritual, environmental and historical place in society with a clear understanding of their role and responsibilities.

Geography is taught by 4 full time specialist teachers. Year 7 is taught in mixed ability tutor groups, Years 8 and 9 are taught in ability groups. GCSE Geography is a popular option choice with just over half the year group opting to take it in 2017/18. We follow the AQA course at G.C.S.E. covering a range of physical and human Geography topics.

Geography has three teaching rooms which are equipped with interactive whiteboards. There is also a range of video and ICT based resources. The girls have access to a range of resources which are on the Moodle.

The students at Millais are able and very well motivated. A teacher is sought who has the ability to engage them in a lively, stimulating and innovative way, so that the girls' skills and enthusiasm will be developed to give them a life-long interest in the subject areas and equip them for the challenges of the international workplace.
