

# School Catchment Areas

How to use the school catchment finder to identify your catchment schools.

All Catholic schools and some Church of England schools, Free schools and Academies in West Sussex have either a parish or other church related catchment area, or no specific catchment area. As these schools do not use a West Sussex County Council defined catchment area they will not appear on this search.



You can page through the results using the arrow(s) in the pop-up box




To see a school's defined catchment area


Click on


