Our Programme

Only the most promising and passionate advocates of children and young people will be selected to take part in our programme. You will need to be a Social Work graduate with:

- Passion to improve the lives of children
- · Ambition and motivation
- Resilience and excellent organisational ability
- Eligible for HCPC registration

For your ASYE you'll be based in an academy team in the North or South of the County, alongside one of our established teams:

- Contact Assessment and Intervention
- Family Support & Protection
- · Children Looked After

On completion of your ASYE we will agree with you which team you will be permanently based in.

We will train you to become the best social worker, developing your competence against both the Knowledge and Skills Statement (KSS) and the Professional Capabilities Framework (PCF).

What you can expect

- Reduced and protected caseloads
- Dedicated training pathway intensive for the first four months
- Resilience training delivered by the University of Chichester (option to complete an assignment and gain post qualifying academic credits)
- Regular reflective supervision
- Group Supervision
- A dedicated Holistic Assessor to help oversee your development
- Support from experienced
