YOU HAVE THE POWER TO HELP PREVENT CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION AND TRAFFICKING

Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) involves young people under the age of 18 being coerced into sexual activity. It takes place throughout the community; including in hotels.



Although it isn't always easy to spot, there are a number of signs to look out for, which could indicate that CSE is taking place.

We need your help to protect children at risk of exploitation.

HAVE YOU SEEN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SIGNS?

Men or women accompanied by girls or boys clearly under the influence of alcohol or drugs



Teenage girls loitering around in public areas or outside the premises



Guests with a local address renting a room



Guests who don't have any luggage or ID



Adults refusing to leave credit card details and paying in cash



Guests asking for a room that is isolated or situated near fire exists



Guests who appear secretive about their visit or trying to conceal their activities in the room or who they are with



Frequent visitors to the hotel who do not appear to have a reason for being there
