The Principal Engineer is one of the lead professionals in the Team. The work will sometimes involve being outside in all weathers, for example, whilst carrying out site visits.

Key skills

- Relevant advanced theoretical knowledge of highway design. Working knowledge of Design Manual for Roads & Bridges (DMRB), Manual for Streets (MfS), and West Sussex County Council policies and procedures.

Qualifications and/or experience

- A degree or postgraduate qualification in Civil Engineering or a related discipline appropriate to the specialist role.
- Extensive experience in the appropriate specialist work area at a senior level.
- Experience of strategic level work and solving complex problems.
- Experience of mentoring staff and developing an effective team to work together to meet objectives and deliver a professional service.

Key Responsibilities

To act as the leading specialist in a particular professional field, acting as the "expert" in matters related to the discipline.

Accurately diagnose highly complex problems, including carrying out site visits and inspections, research the issues, produce a range of possible solutions by applying the right concepts and tools and consult with the client in order to agree a robust course of action.

Monitor and manage small budgets (£15,000 per annum) in order to support or deliver project work, for example, through the appointment of contractors.

To be responsible for managing the professional development of staff. Including establishing mentoring for individuals and balancing skills with ongoing training and development.

Create or interpret technical drawings, such as plans or maps, using specialist software.

Engage positively and proactively with the wider community, through bodies such as parish councils and conservation groups, to ensure that their views are known and have influence whilst the role of the County Council is understood.

Articulate with developers in respect of particular considerations, providing them with advice and on occasion, negotiate with them in respect of proposed developments.
