NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (install double yellow lines) on the eastern side of Bilsham Road in Yapton, for a distance of 15 metres either side of its junction with Cinders Lane.

The documents may also be inspected at County Hall Chichester, during normal office hours, and at Littlehampton Library, Maltravers Road, Littlehampton during normal library opening hours.

STATEMENT OF REASONS
FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time (install double yellow lines) on the eastern side of Bilsham Road in Yapton, for a distance of 15 metres either side of its junction with Cinders Lane.

Planning permission has been granted for the construction of a new residential property development on land east of Bilsham Road. This development will be accessed via Cinder's Lane. During the planning process it was identified that cars parking close to Cinders Lane would obscure visibility for vehicles accessing the new development, so it is proposed to install double yellow lines for 15 metres either side of the junction to maintain acceptable visibility splays for the increased number of vehicles using the junction.

The new Order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to traffic using the road.

The attached drawings, numbered SU9702NEN shows the length of road affected by the proposed Order.
