(Yapton: Footpath 167) (Temporary Closure) Order 2019

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has consented to the extension of the operation of the above Temporary Traffic Regulation Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 temporarily closing Public Footpath No. 166 in Yapton, from its junction with Burndell Road, southwards to its junction with Footpath No. 166 (adjacent to the allotments).

The continued closure of this footpath is necessary to allow a new residential property development to be constructed in safety.

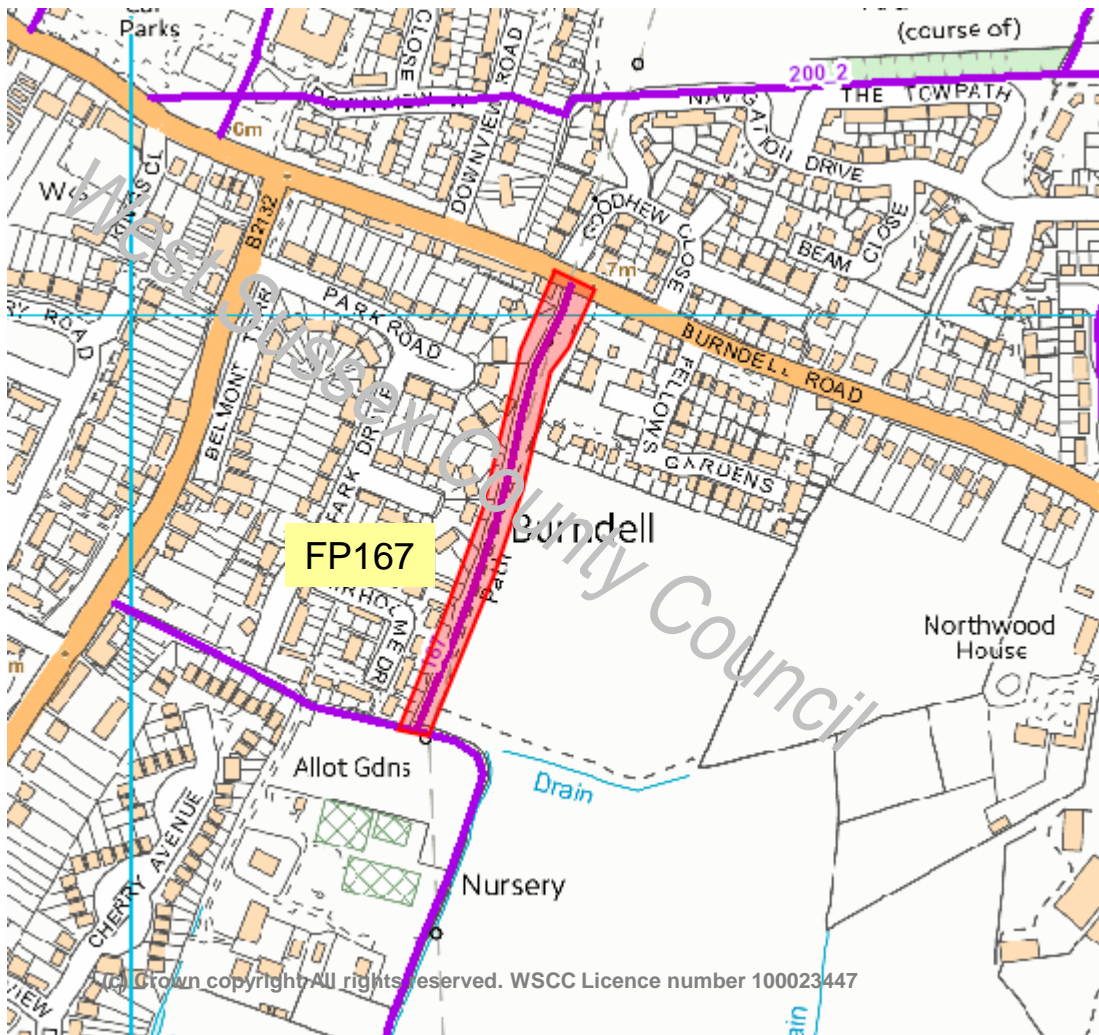
The Order will now remain in force until **8 May 2021** or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier.

Unfortunately, during the operative periods of this order no alternative routes are available via the public rights of way network.
