(Ansty & Staplefield: Public Footpath 104CR) (Temporary Closure) Order 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that The Secretary of State for Transport has given permission to extend the operation of the above Traffic Regulation Order, which presently enacts the temporary closure of Public Footpath No. 104CR in the parish of Ansty & Staplefield from its north-eastern end near Rookery Lane, south-westwards for a distance of 222 metres.

The continued closure of this footpath is needed to maintain public safety while a property development is built on adjacent land.

The Order will continue in effect until 21 July 2022 or the ongoing works are completed, whichever is earlier.

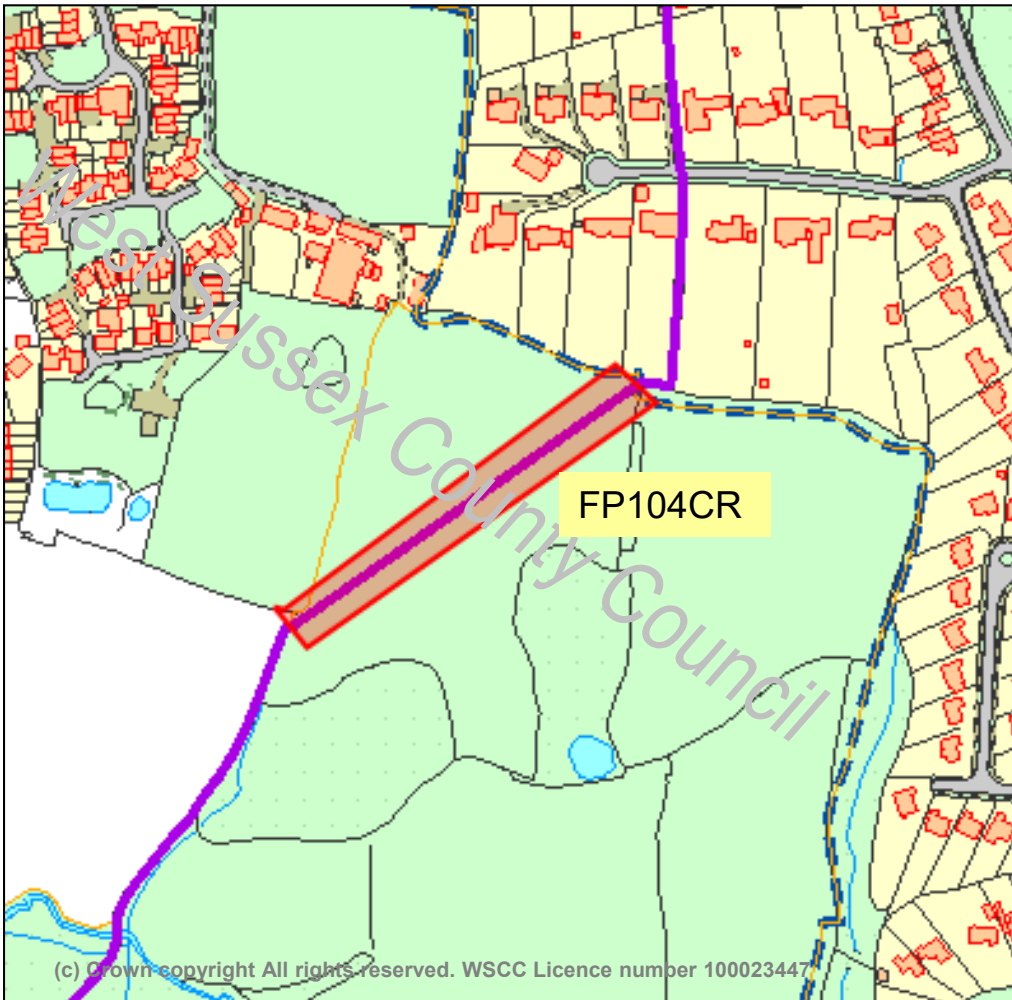
Unfortunately, while the Order is in effect, no alternative route is available via the public rights of way network.
