NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council propose to make a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce lengths of prohibition of waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on sections of High Street, Partridge Green between South Street and Oakwood

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to introduce a permanent Order the effect of which will be to introduce lengths of prohibition of waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on sections of High Street, Partridge Green between South Street and Oakwood

A community highway scheme is being introduced in the High Street Partridge Green. The scheme will include traffic calming give and take build-outs and uncontrolled pedestrian crossing facilities to reduce traffic speeds.

There is a concern that vehicles will park adjacent to the build-outs and obstruct the visibility of pedestrians waiting to cross. It is therefore proposed to introduce lengths of double yellow lines to assist in keeping these areas clear of parked vehicles

This Order is proposed for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs and avoiding danger to persons or traffic using the road, for preventing damage to the road, and to facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic.
