






















Let's see what we have talked about and written down

- **MATCHES AND LIGHTERS** - matches and lighters are only to be used by grown-ups! Did you talk about the things that grown-ups use them for: lighting candles, bonfires, BBQs and more?

Fire is dangerous and a small fire can grow very quickly!

Matches and lighters should be kept in a safe place, like a high shelf and should not be touched by children! We have a rhyme that we would like you to learn:

**Matches, Lighters, never touch,
They can hurt you very much!**

- **KETTLE AND CUP** - the cup looks empty but it would be very dangerous if it was a hot drink - you may see steam coming from the top.

Make sure you are very careful when grown-ups have hot drinks as we do not want anyone to get burnt.

- **HOT CUP** - This is a hot drink! There is steam coming out of the top so we know that it is hot and can burn us if we are not careful!
- **BATH** - Make sure a grown-up tests the bath before you get into it! It may be too hot.

- **HAIR STRAIGHTENERS** - Someone at home may use hair straighteners and leave them out to cool down before putting them away. They can get very hot and take a long time to cool down. Can we tell if they are hot or not? No - so do not touch.
- **COOKER** - We can't always tell if cookers are hot or not so it's best to stay away. When adults are cooking, we shouldn't be playing near the cooker. Handles on saucepans should not be facing outwards if possible so they won't get knocked off.
- **SMOKE ALARM** - A smoke alarm is important in our homes as its job is to smell for smoke day and night. Have a look to see if you can find one on the ceiling on each floor of your house and ask the grown-ups if you can help them test it every week.

I expect you have heard the smoke alarm go off in your home when a grown-up has been cooking. The smoke alarm does not know the difference between a real fire and the grown-ups cooking. A grown-up will tell you when they have set it off accidentally.

- **OPEN SMOKE ALARM** - I am sure you saw the smoke alarm on the ceiling but did you see that it was open and the battery was on the table. The smoke alarm would not work in this house!
- **PERSON MAKING A PHONE CALL** - Did you spot that the person is making a call from inside the house? If the smoke alarm had beeped to tell everyone, there might be a fire.

It is important for everyone to get out, stay out and call 999.

- **PEOPLE STANDING OUTSIDE** - I expect you saw that people were standing outside in their pyjamas! The smoke alarm had told them there could be a fire in their house so they had to get out, stay out and call 999.
- **'999'** - Do you know what you would say if you had to report a real emergency. Did you talk about what you would say?
