(Haywards Heath: Public Footpath 19dCU) (Temporary Closure) Order 2019

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has consented to a further extension of the operation of the above Temporary Traffic Regulation Order, made by West Sussex County Council intends to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, temporarily closing Public Footpath 19dCU (Sussex Diamond Way) in Haywards Heath, from a point 85 metres west of Penland Farm, eastwards for a distance of 225 metres.

The continued closure of this public footpath is needed to maintain public safety while a property development is built on adjacent land.

The Order will now remain in force until 23 April 2021, or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier.

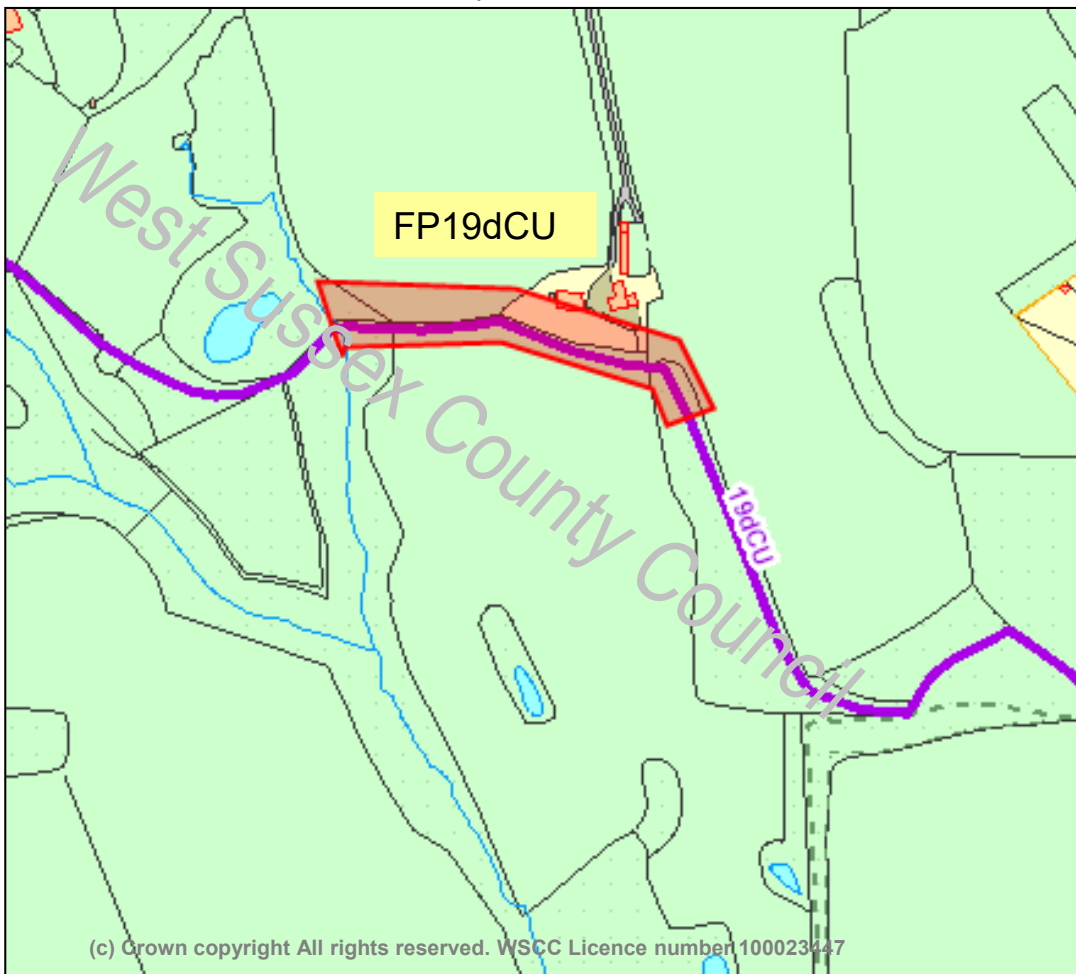
During the operative periods of this Order there are unfortunately no available alternative routes via the public rights of way network.
