

Frosty Light Jars

These lovely jars can be reused after the festive season!



You will need:

A collection of clean glass jars rescued from your recycling bin, with labels removed

Salt (I found that mixing fine and large salt grains works well)

Bowl/dish for putting the salt in

Water based craft glue and a small brush to spread with

Some coloured yarn or ribbon to decorate

rechargeable lights or tea light for each jar

Instructions:

Ensure jars are clean and dry.

Sprinkle salt into the dish to cover the bottom.

Using the craft glue, squeeze some onto bottom and top edge of jar, then spread out to create a runny effect like melting snow.

Push the glued areas into the salt and sprinkle some more loose salt below the rim and any areas where the salt didn't stick well.

Leave to dry for 15 mins.

Wrap a length of yarn or ribbon around the rim of the jar to decorate, fixing ends down with a dab of glue.

Place lights or candle in each jar for a snowy light effect.



Please note: If you use washable glue you will be able to clean the jars in soapy water after the festivities and re-decorate the jars in other ways to make storage vessels or pen pots!
