Death and Bereavement – Teenage Booklist

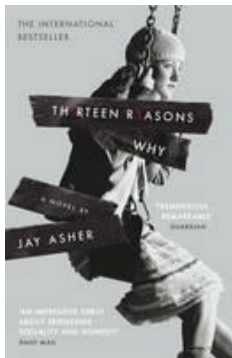
Teenage (Age 11+) and Teenage+ (Age 14+)
