(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council on 23 June 2020 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which came into force on 1 July 2020, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 30 September 2021 or until the works are completed.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to a broken bridge.

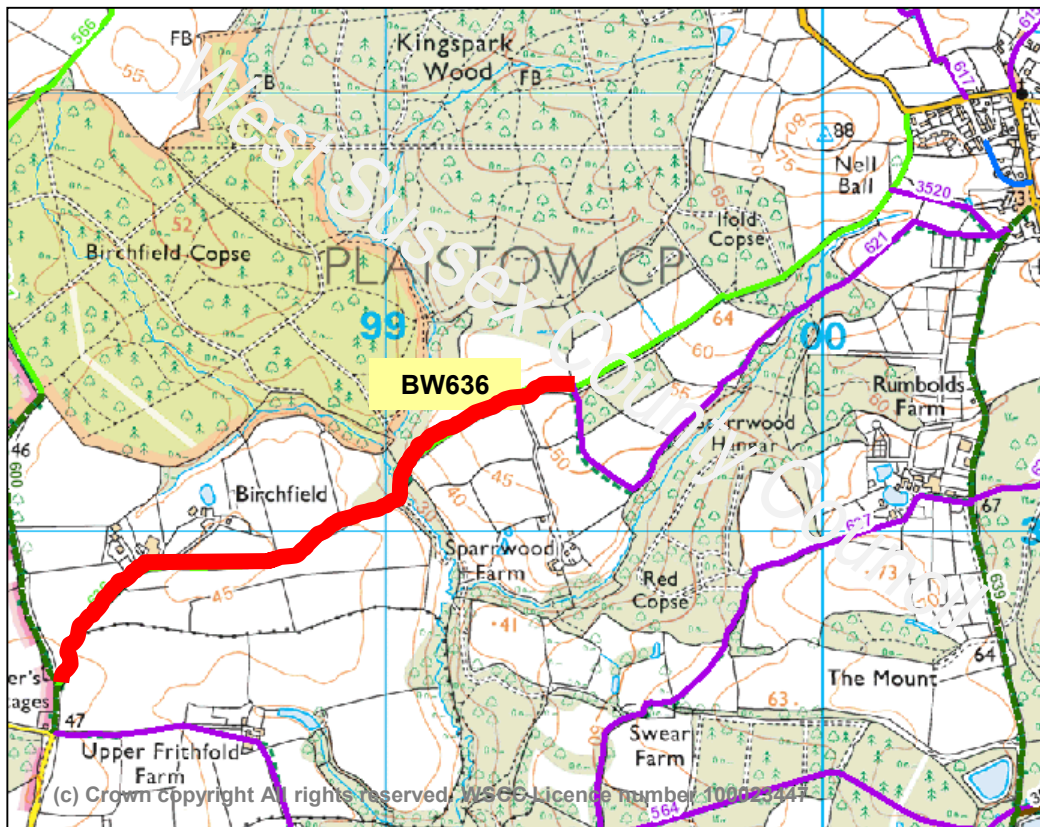
The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along the length of Public Bridleway No. 636, from its western end at its junction with Restricted Byway No. 600 (SU 982296), running in a north-easterly direction for 1500 metres to its junction with Public Footpath No. 621(SU 994303).

Unfortunately there are no alternative routes available using the Public Rights of Way network.
