(Ansty & Staplefield: Public Footpath 23CR) (Temporary Closure) Order 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily close Public Footpath 23CR in Ansty & Staplefield, from its junction with Broxmead Lane, eastwards to its junction with Deaks Lane.

The closure of this footpath is needed due to the unsafe condition of a footbridge on the route.

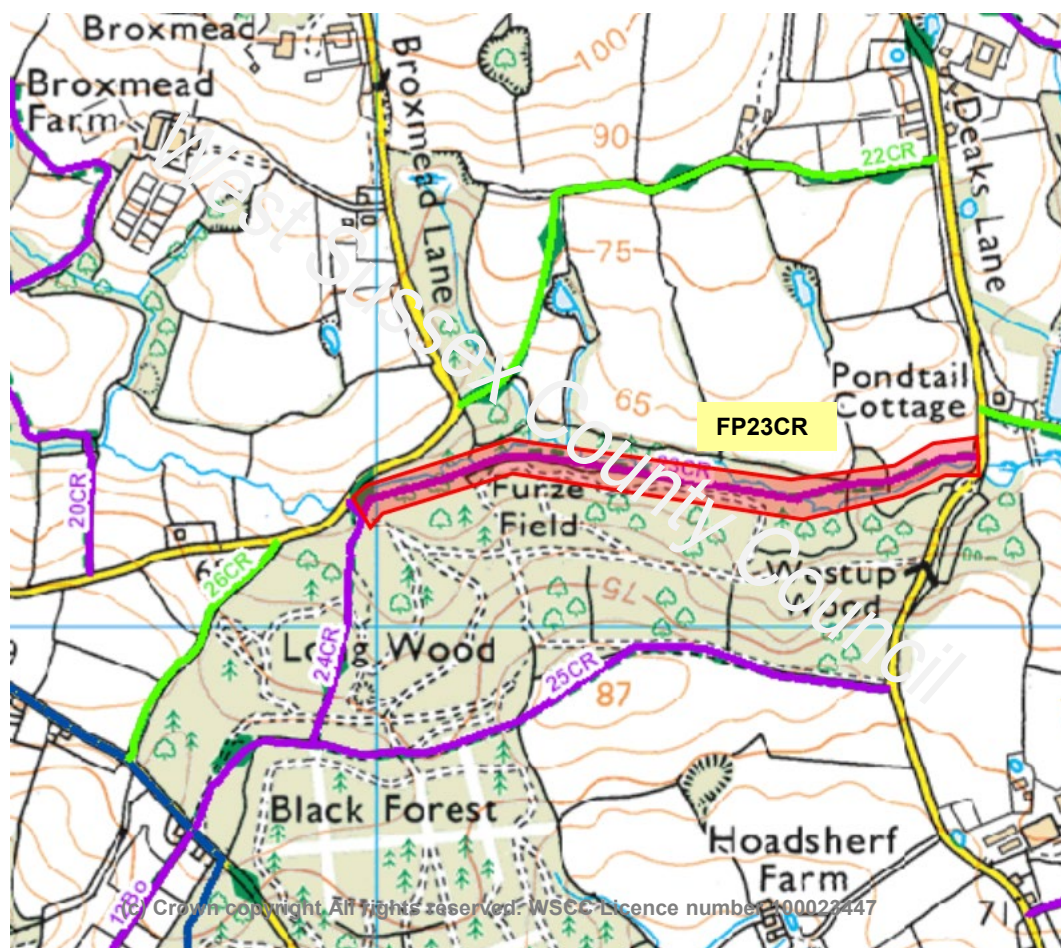
The Order will come into effect on 15 March 2021 and remain in force for 6 months, or until repairs are carried out, whichever is earlier.

Unfortunately, during the operative period of this order, no direct alternative route is available via the public rights of way network.
