(SOUTHWATER: PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 1669)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2019

NOTICE is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which came into force on 29 October 2020, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 28 October 2021 or until it is safe to reopen the footpath.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst construction works are undertaken in the vicinity.

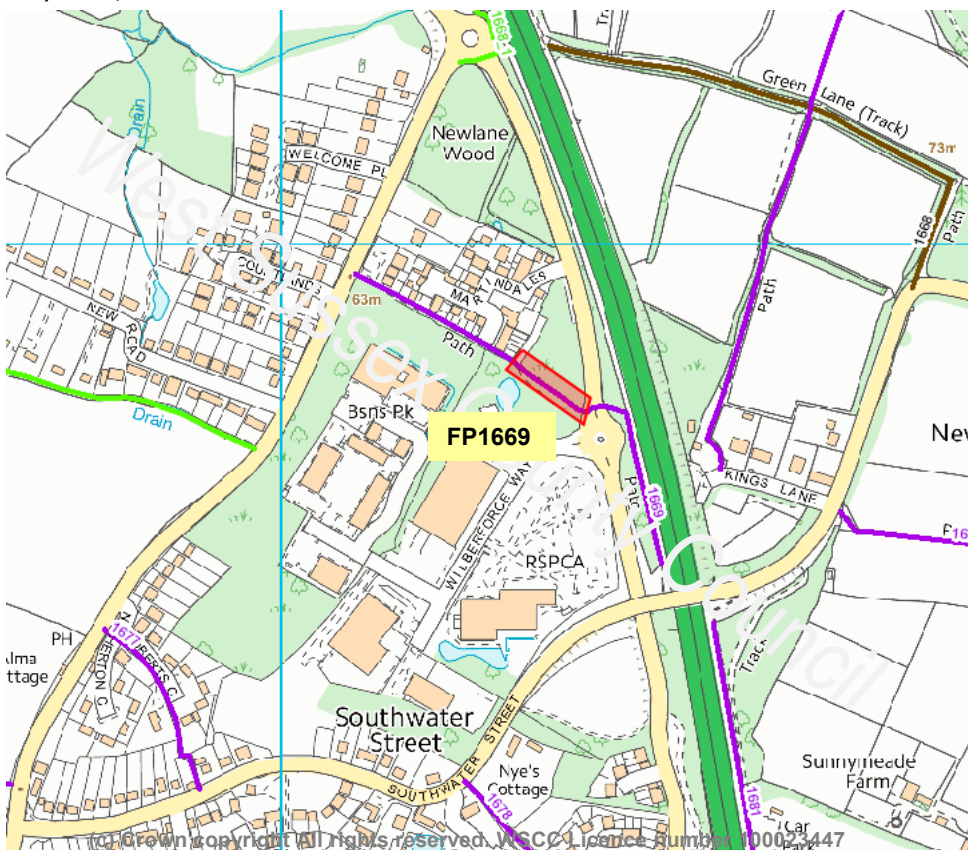
The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 1669, Southwater from its northern end at its junction with Worthing Road (TQ167279), south-eastwards to its junction with Blakes Farm Road (TQ162278).

Unfortunately there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network.
