

**West Sussex County Council**  
**(South Stoke: Public Footpath 2266) (Temporary Closure) Order 2021**

NOTICE is hereby given that not less than 7 days from the date of this notice, West Sussex County Council intends to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily close Public Footpath 2266 in the parish of South Stoke, from its junction with Mill Road, eastwards to the River Arun.

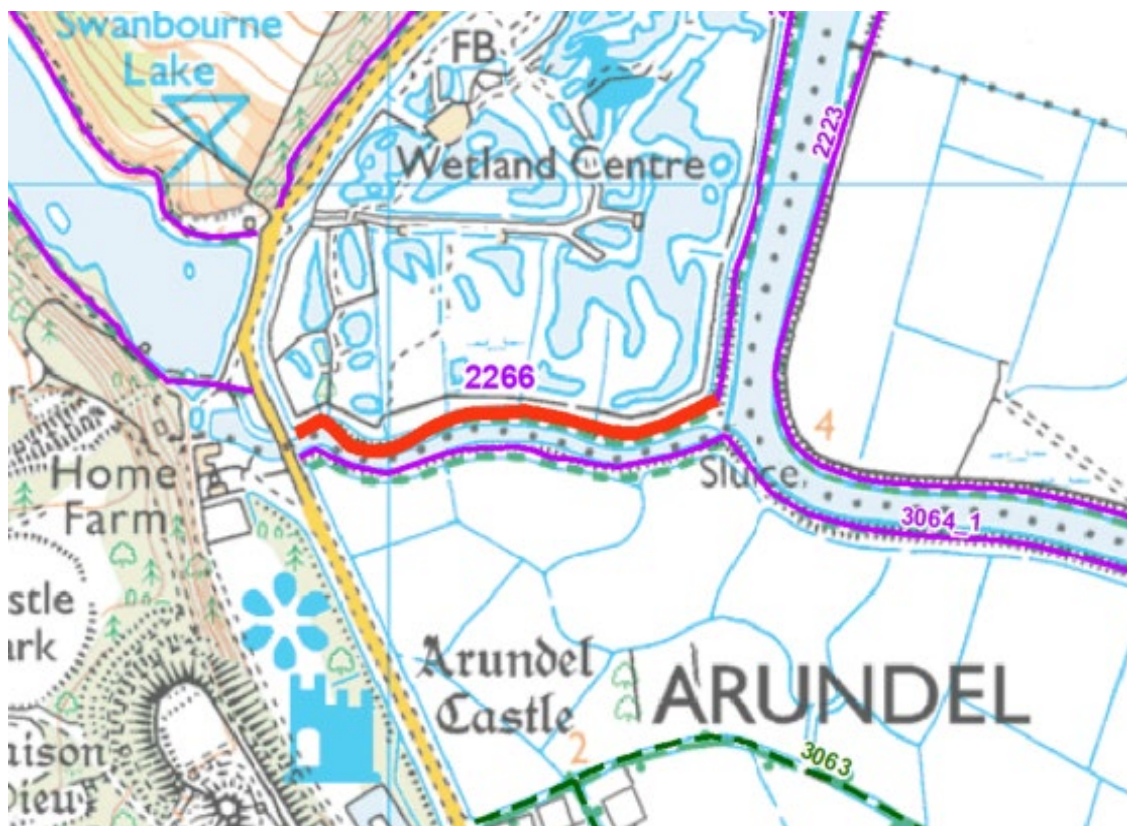
The closure of this footpath is needed due to the unsafe condition of trees adjacent to the footpath.

The Order extends the effect of an emergency notice and will come into effect on 5 July 2021. IT is expected to remain in force for up to 6 months, or until tree felling works are carried out, whichever is earlier.
