

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(KIRDFORD: PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO. 614)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Bridleway No. 614 Kirdford, from its western end at its junction with Croucham Lane (TQ 018246), running in an easterly direction for 670 metres to its junction with Public Footpath No. 614_1 (TQ 024245).

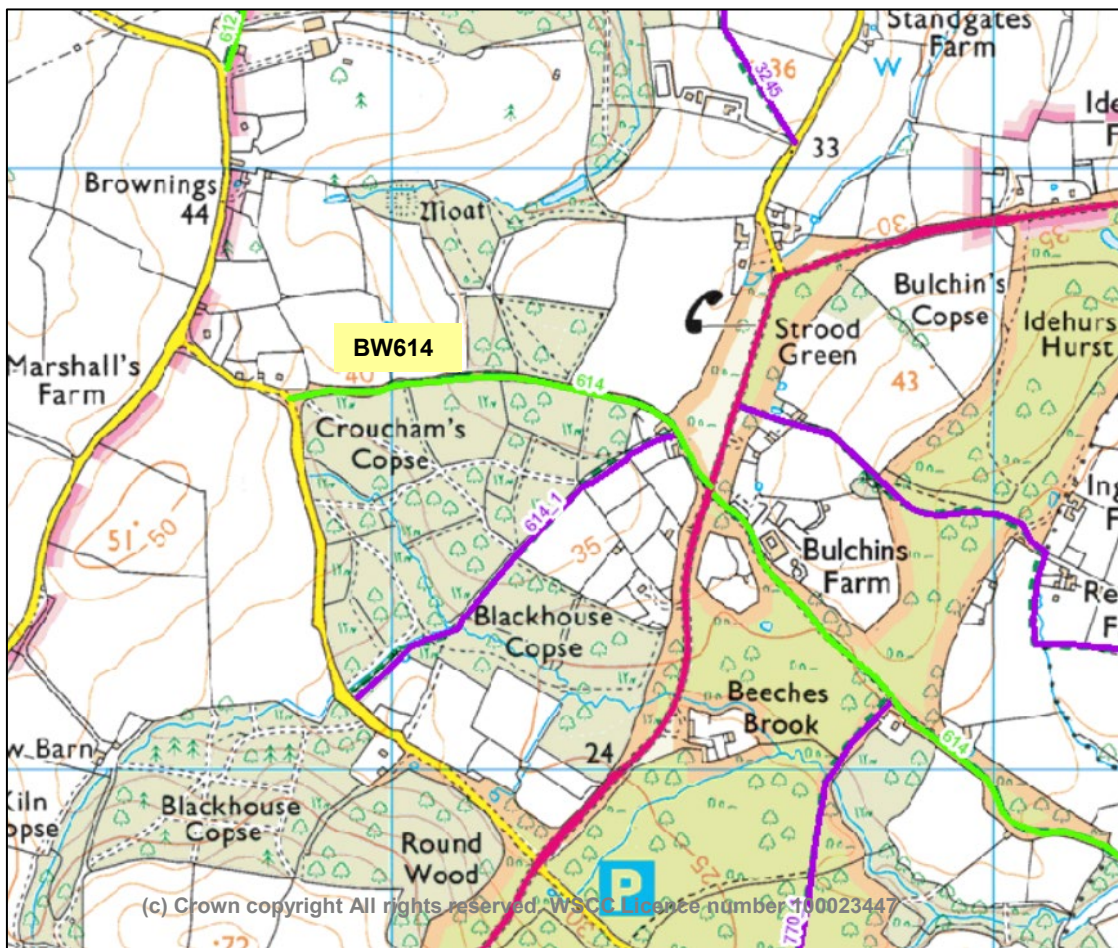
The Order is necessary due to the suspension of surface improvement works as a result of poor ground conditions.

Unfortunately there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network. The Order will come into effect on 1st December 2021 and will last for 6 months or until the Public Bridleway is safe to reopen whichever is sooner.
