**(FERNHURST: PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY No. 1265)**  
**(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council on 17 June 2021 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which came into force on 21 June 2021 with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 20 June 2022 or until the works are completed.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst renovation works are undertaken on the dam.

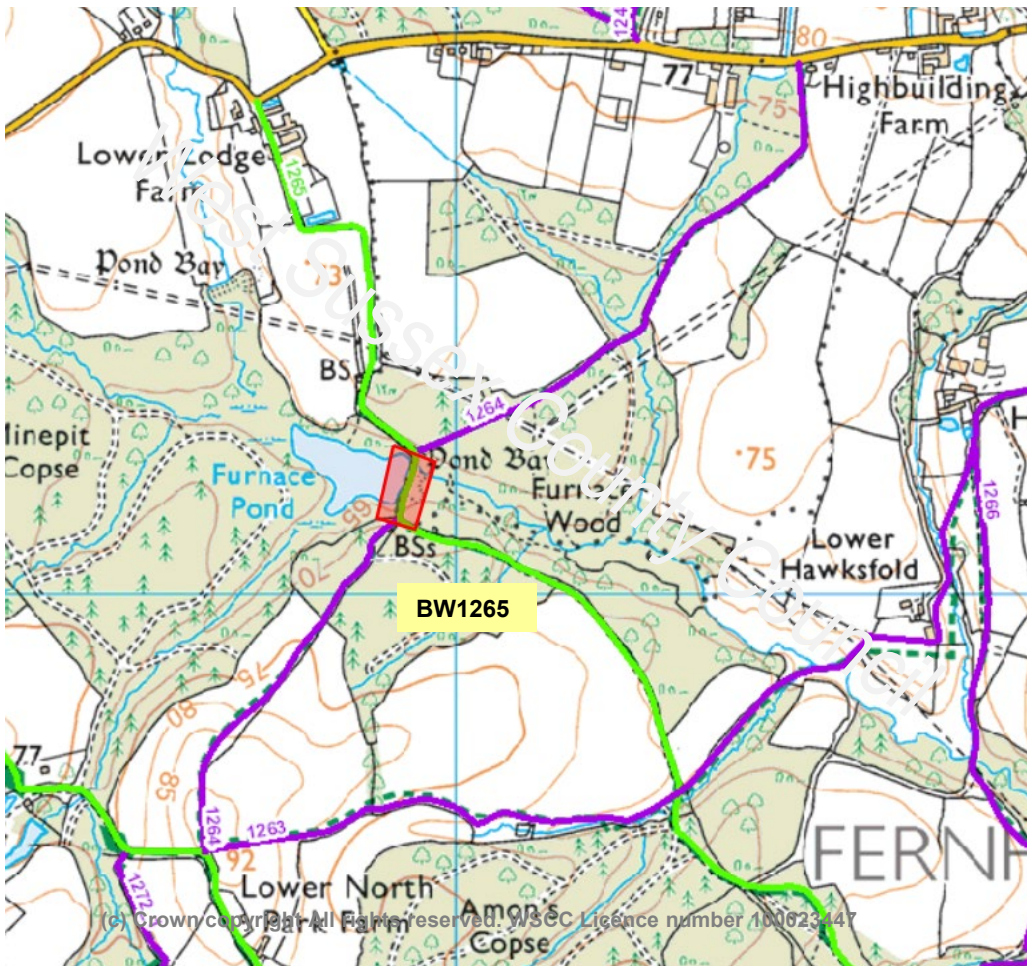
The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Bridleway No. 1265 Fernhurst, from its junction with Public Footpath 1264 (SU879282), running in a southerly direction to its junction with Public Footpath No. 1264 (SU879281), a distance of approximately 75 metres.

Unfortunately there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network.
