NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 50 MPH speed limit on Steyning Road (A283) in Shoreham-By-Sea, from the A27 interchange roundabout, southwards to the current 30 mph speed limit which begins near St Nicholas Church.

NOTICE is also herby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to install a new Toucan crossing for pedestrians and cycles, on Steyning Road (A283) immediately north of the current bus stop located outside the Red Lion public house.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the West Sussex County Council website. The <u>website</u> includes a response form for any comments or objections.

Shoreham-By-Sea; Steyning Road (A283) Pedestrian Crossing Place

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce a 50 MPH speed limit on Steyning Road (A283) in Shoreham-By-Sea, from the A27 interchange roundabout, southwards to the current 30 mph speed limit which begins near St Nicholas Church.

It is also proposed to install a new Toucan crossing for pedestrians and cycles, on Steyning Road (A283) immediately north of the current bus stop located outside the Red Lion public house.

The new crossing is proposed to provide safe access for pedestrians and cyclists between Shoreham and the popular Downs Link route, as well as the nearby Shoreham Tollbridge.

The length of Steyning Road between the A27 interchange and Shoreham presently has a 60 MPH speed limit and this was assessed as part of the work to design the proposed pedestrian crossing. It was considered that that reducing the speed limit to 50 MPH would improve compliance with the current 30 MPH speed limit on Steyning Road north of Upper Shoreham Road, particularly for southbound drivers, and that this was desirable to maintain safety on the new crossing.

The new speed limit order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, numbered 4935-002, shows the proposed new speed limit. Drawing number 70083871 shows the location of the proposed new crossing.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (SHOREHAM-BY-SEA: STEYNING ROAD (A283)) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Shoreham-By-Sea: Steyning Road (A283)) (50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2022"
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Paragraph 2 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

From a point 170 metres north of its junction with Upper Shoreham Road, northwards to its junction with the roundabout at the A27 interchange.
