(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice West Sussex County Council intends to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 1669, Southwater from its northern end at its junction with Blakes Farm Road (TQ162278), running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 90 metres to the edge of the Martindales estate (TQ162278).

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst construction works are undertaken in the vicinity.

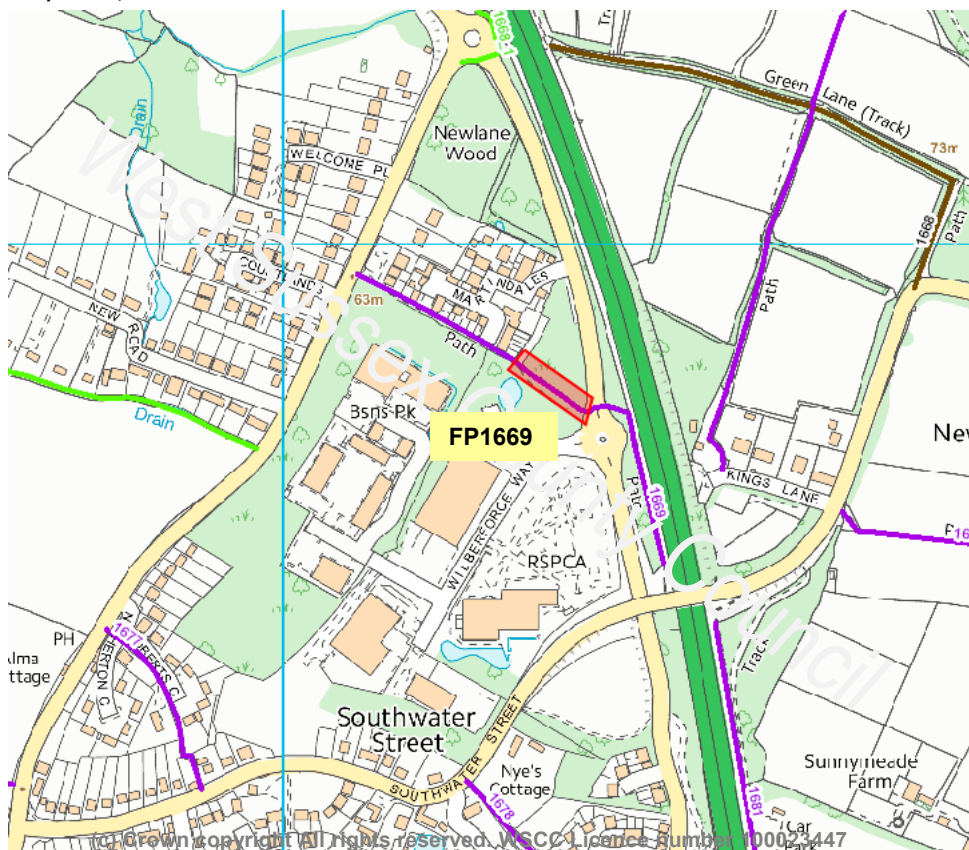
Unfortunately there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network.

The Order will come into effect on 28 March 2022 and will last for 6 months.
