NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic regulation Orders under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be as follows:

The first Order will prohibit waiting at any time (install double yellow lines) on lengths of both sides of Virginia Drive in Haywards Heath, between its junctions with Rocky Lane and Vita Close.

The second Order will introduce a 20 MPH speed limit throughout all lengths of Virginia Drive and all other new roads within the recently constructed Wychwood Park residential property development.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the West Sussex County Council website. The <u>website</u> includes a response form for any comments or objections.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Orders

West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic Regulation Orders the effect of which will be as follows:

The first Order will prohibit waiting at any time (install double yellow lines) on lengths of both sides of Virginia Drive in Haywards Heath, between its junctions with Rocky Lane and Vita Close.

The second Order will introduce a 20 MPH speed limit throughout all lengths of Virginia Drive and all other new roads within the recently constructed Wychwood Park residential property development.

The Wychwood Park residential property development has recently been constructed on land south of Rocky Lane in Haywards Heath. Access through the development is provided by a spine road named Virginia Drive. The proposed waiting restrictions were specified during planning for the development and are intended to keep the road clear of parking at its northern end near the junction with Rocky Lane.

The layout of all roads in the new development have been designed to encourage traffic speeds of 20 miles per hour or less. The proposed 20 MPH speed limit throughout the new development is intended to formalise this and ensure safety on the new roads.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to facilitate the passage of traffic

The attached drawings, numbered TQ3322NWS and TQ3322SWN show the lengths of road affected by the proposed parking restrictions. Drawing number CMS9024 shows the proposed speed limits.

<u>WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (HAYWARDS HEATH: VIRGINIA DRIVE AND VARIOUS ROADS) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Haywards Heath: Virginia Drive and Various Roads) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2022"
- 2. The length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall not be restricted roads for the purpose of Section 82(2) of the Act.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Paragraph 2 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –

(a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and

(b) the vehicle is being driven-

(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or

(ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.




