NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of Ashacre Lane in Worthing, from its junction with Half Moon Lane, southwards to the existing double yellow lines which begin north of the bend outside no. 101 Ashacre Lane.

(Ashacre Lane Amendment) Order 2022

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of Ashacre Lane in Worthing, from its junction with Half Moon Lane, southwards to the existing double yellow lines which begin north of the bend outside no. 101 Ashacre Lane.

The affected length of Ashacre Lane is narrow, with limited visibility due to sharp bends to the north and south. Vehicles are frequently parked on both sides of this part of the road, and normally park on the pavement, presumably in an attempt to provide width for traffic to pass. These parked vehicles severely restrict visibility for residents accessing driveways, resulting in frequent near-misses on this busy road. Footways on the affected length of road are narrow and parked cars on them obstruct pedestrians, particularly wheelchair users or those with pushchairs. Damage to vehicles has also been reported, most often with wingmirrors of passing cars and parked cars being hit as vehicles try to pass in the narrowed carriageway.

The new order is therefore proposed to facilitate the passage of traffic and to avoid danger to persons or traffic using the affected length of road.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ1205SES shows the length of road affected by the proposed order.


