NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) at the junction of High Street with Fairfields; and

To prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the western side of South Farm Road at the accesses to two private off-street parking areas located immediately north of the junction with Loder Gardens.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the West Sussex County Council website. The <u>website</u> includes a response form for any comments or objections.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will:

Prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) at the junction of High Street with Fairfields; and

Prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the western side of South Farm Road at the accesses to two private off-street parking areas located immediately north of the junction with Loder Gardens.

Currently the length of High Street either side of its junction with Fairfields is subject to a single yellow line which prohibits vehicles waiting 8.30am to 6pm Mon to Sat. Access to Fairfields is needed at all times and the current restriction is therefore considered inadequate. It is therefore proposed to replace the current single yellow line with double yellow lines, to prohibit waiting at any time. The new lines would be extended into Fairfields to prevent cars parking too close to the junction.

When advertising the proposed revision in High Street, the opportunity is being taken to address a problem on South Farm Road, where a parking bay on the western side of the road, immediately south of Loder Gardens, extends across the dropped kerbs giving access to two private parking areas. These presently have white 'access protection' lines, but they are frequently ignored, leaving access to the private parking areas obstructed. It is proposed to replace the access protection lines with double yellow lines to resolve this problem.

The new order is therefore proposed to facilitate the passage of traffic and to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ1304SWN, TQ1304SWS and TQ1404SWS show the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.








PAGE 2 OF 2: PROPOSED CHANGES TO RESTRICTIONS (CIRCLED)






