(Lyminster & Crossbush and Poling: Bridleway 2163) (Temporary Closure) Order 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State has granted permission for the extension of the above Order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is currently enacting the closure of Bridleway 2163 in the parishes of Lyminster & Crossbush and Poling, from its junction with the A284, eastwards to its junction with public footpath 2202_1, a distance of approximately 1.1km.

The extended closure of this route is necessary to maintain public safety during the construction of the new Lyminster bypass.

The Order will now remain in effect until 19 April 2024, or until the ongoing works are completed, whichever is earlier.

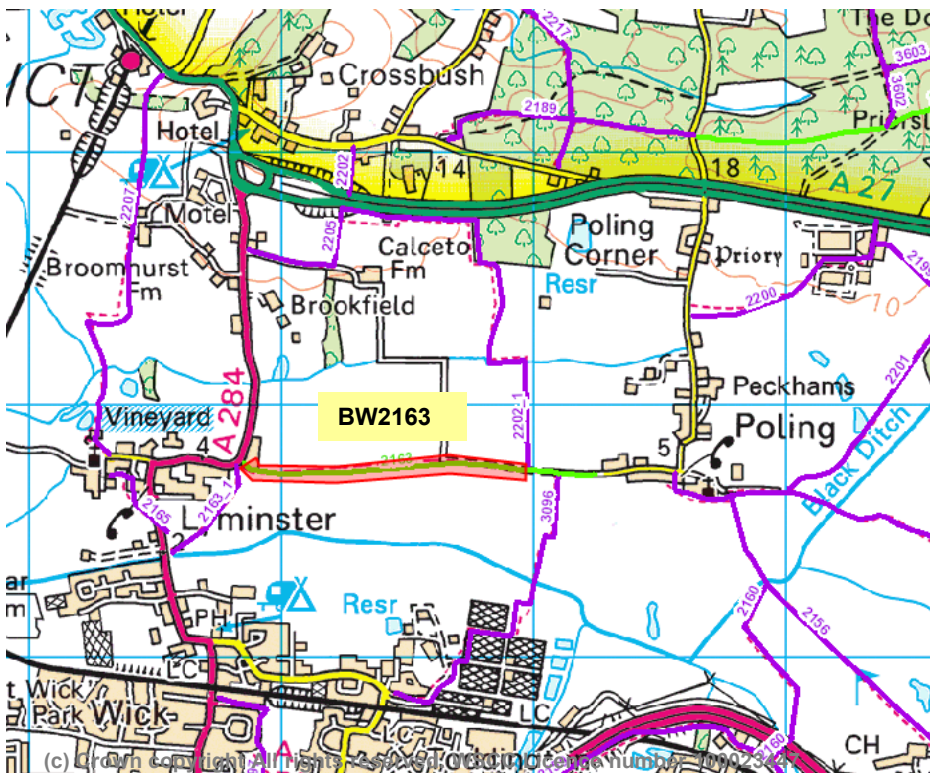
Unfortunately, while the Order is in force no alternative route is available via the public rights of way network.
