- (ii) introduce a loading bay for Goods Vehicles only on the western side of Exchange Road

Statement of reasons for proposing to make the Traffic Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Traffic Order the effect of which will be to:

- (i) introduce 6 disabled bays on the northern side of The Boulevard adjacent to the new town hall; and
- (ii) introduce a loading bay for Goods Vehicles only on the western side of Exchange Road

The Eastern Gateway is a Council project within the Crawley Growth programme. It aims to deliver better public space and connectivity improvements at the Town Hall, County Buildings and Crawley College

The old Town Hall has been replaced with a building containing a new Town Hall with commercial offices above. The new Town Hall building will accommodate a range of staff and commercial tenants. To limit vehicular traffic in The Boulevard whilst providing a parking facility for blue badge holders the parking space in front of the Town Hall building will be designated with 6 parking spaces for disabled vehicles only.

A loading bay for Goods Vehicles only will be provided to the rear of the new Town Hall building in Exchange Road. This facility is being provided to deter Goods Vehicles from routinely loading and unloading on double yellow lines and will provide a space for this activity to take place.

The opportunity is being taken to amend the Traffic Order plans by the removal of waiting restrictions from lengths of Milton Mount that do not form part of the publicly maintainable highway and, by the correction of the road name for Haslett Avenue East which is currently shown as Worth Park Avenue.

The scheme is proposed for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, to facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.










