Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce a parking restriction limiting waiting to a maximum of 1 hour, no return within 1 hour, Mon-Sat on the eastern side of London Road in Sayers Common, outside the Sayers Common Community Shop.

It is reported that the layby outside Sayers Common Community Shop is often used to park vehicles all day. This long-stay parking takes up spaces which would otherwise be used by visitors to the shop and affects deliveries.

On this basis, the shop has applied to West Sussex County Council for limited waiting restrictions to provide a turnover of parking spaces for customers. This has been accepted for progression under the community Traffic Regulation Order process.

The new order is therefore proposed to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached drawing, numbered TQ2618SEN shows the length of road affected by the proposed order.


