NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on lengths of Holmbush Way in Southwick as follows:

a) at its junction with Upper Kingston Lane; b) on short lengths between its junctions with Whitelot Way and Overhill, and c) on the north side of the road opposite its junction with Kings Road.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the <u>West Sussex County Council website</u>. The website includes a response form for any comments or objections.

(Southwick: Holmbush Way Amendment) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on lengths of Holmbush Way in Southwick as follows:

a) at its junction with Upper Kingston Lane; b) on short lengths between its junctions with Whitelot Way and Overhill, and c) on the north side of the road opposite its junction with Kings Road.

Holmbush way is on a bus route and has bus stops at various locations along its length. Vehicles parking close to the bus stop markings frequently prevent buses pulling into these bus stops. The proposed new restrictions on Holmbush Way near its junction with Overhill and opposite Kings Road provide short lengths of double yellow lines either side of bus stops to ensure buses can safely pull in to pick up/set down passengers at the kerb, improving safety for passengers and avoiding obstruction to other traffic passing along the road. The restrictions at the junction of Holmbush Way and Upper Kingston Lane are intended to improve visibility at the junction.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to facilitate the passage of traffic.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ2306SEN and TQ2406SWN show the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.






