NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the 40 MPH speed limit on Albourne Road (B2116) in the parishes of Albourne and Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common, so that it runs from its junction with London Road (B2118) eastwards to a point 50m west of its junction with Langton Lane.

<u>West Sussex County Council</u> (Albourne and Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common: Albourne Road (B2116)) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will extend the 40 MPH speed limit on Albourne Road (B2116) in the parishes of Albourne and Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common, so that it runs from its junction with London Road (B2118) eastwards to a point 50m west of its junction with Langton Lane.

Currently there is a short length of national (60 MPH) speed limit on Albourne Road between the 40 MPH speed limit at Albourne and the 30 MPH speed limit at Hurstpierpoint. Residents have requested a review of this speed limit on the grounds that such a short length of national speed limit is unnecessary, is inappropriate given residential properties in the area and makes Albourne Road hazardous to cross.

On review this request complies with the aims of the West Sussex County Council Speed Limit policy, with this route meeting the criteria for a 40 MPH speed limit. It is therefore considered appropriate to extend the 40 MPH speed limit at Albourne eastwards to join the existing 30 MPH speed limit at Hurstpierpoint.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, numbered MDS2305 shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (ALBOURNE AND HURSTPIERPOINT & SAYERS COMMON: ALBOURNE ROAD (B2116)) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Albourne and Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common: Albourne Road (B2116)) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023"
- 2. The Part of the Order Specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Paragraph 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
