NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make permanent Traffic Orders, the effect of which will be to:

- (i) introduce a 20mph speed limit on Ashfield Road between Bepton Road and Petersfield Road; and
- (ii) permit motor vehicles to only travel southwards on Ashfield Road between Bepton Road and Petersfield Road. Pedal cyclists will be permitted to cycle in both directions, and
- (iii) introduce lengths of prohibition of waiting at all times (double yellow lines) on Ashfield Road on the western side at the junction of the spur leading to Midhurst C of E Primary School and a 10 metres length on the eastern side adjacent to Nos. 31 and 32.

The consultation for this proposal will start on 15 June 2023 and, AT THAT TIME, full details of the proposals in this Notice can be viewed on the TRO pages of the <u>West Sussex County</u> <u>Council website</u>. The website includes a response form for comments or objections.

Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 propose to make permanent Traffic Order the effect of which will be to

- (i) introduce a 20mph speed limit on Ashfield Road between Bepton Road and Petersfield Road; and
- (ii) permit motor vehicles to only travel southwards on Ashfield Road between Bepton Road and Petersfield Road. Pedal cyclists will be permitted to cycle in both directions, and
- (iii)introduce lengths of prohibition of waiting at all times (double yellow lines) on Ashfield Road on the western side at the junction of the spur leading to Midhurst C of E Primary School and a 10 metre length on the eastern side adjacent to Nos. 31 and 32.

This is a community highway scheme for a one-way restriction with a cycle contraflow on Ashfield Road. Vehicular traffic will be permitted to travel southbound whilst maintaining contra-flow cycling to promote sustainable travel.

Ashfield Road is currently subject to a 30 mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting. The scheme proposes a 20mph speed limit be introduced to ensure traffic speeds remain low.

The Stage 2 Safety Audit recommended that double yellow lines be introduced at the junction with the spur road which leads to the primary school to deter parked vehicles from obscuring sightlines and to maintain visibility. Also a length of double yellow lines proposed to act as refuge so that vehicular traffic and cyclists can pass each other safely.

This Order is proposed so as to reduce danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic and for preserving or improving the amenities of the are through which the road runs.

Drawing Ashfield Road Midhurst One-Way 20mph and plan SU8821SWN show the length of road, which is the subject of the proposed Orders.

<u>WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (<u>MIDHURST: ASHFIELD ROAD</u>) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT & ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2) and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

<u>PART I</u> GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

 This Order shall come into operation on the X day of X 2023 and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Midhurst: Ashfield Road) (20mph Speed Limit & One-Way Traffic) Order 2023."

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:-

"Council" means either/both District Council or/and County Council;

"County Council" means West Sussex County Council;

"District Council" means Horsham District Council;

"pedal cycle" means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels not being in any case a motor cycle;

"vehicle" has the same meaning as that assigned to "motor vehicle" in section 136(1) of the Act.

(2) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

PART II SPEED LIMIT PROVISIONS

- 3. The length of restricted road in the First Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Paragraph 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –

(a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and

(b) the vehicle is being driven-

(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or

(ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

PART III ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PROVISIONS

- 6. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road at any time.
- 7. Nothing in Article 6 shall apply to a pedal cycle
- 8. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall apply in respect of a vehicle being used:-
 - (a) for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in the event of an emergency; or
 - (b) with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
 - (c) (with the prior permission of the Council) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal on or near the said roads of any sewer pipe conduit wire cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas water electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 resulting from works or an emergency; or
 - (d) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of its statutory powers or duties; or
 - (e) in association with an event for which a road closure order under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has been made by Horsham District Council.
 - 9. If it appears to the County Council essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or the provision of suitable adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, they may after
 - (a) consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, and
 - (b) giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct,

make modifications or suspend the Order or any provision contained therein.


