West Sussex County Council (Fulking: Clappers Lane) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 MPH Speed limit on Clappers Lane in Fulking, from its junction with Holmbush Lane, southwards to the existing 20 MPH Speed limit at the entrance to the Cricket Ground.

West Sussex County Council (Fulking: Clappers Lane) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce a 30 MPH Speed limit on Clappers Lane in Fulking, from its junction with Holmbush Lane, southwards to the existing 20 MPH Speed limit at the entrance to the Cricket Ground.

The new speed limit has been requested by local residents and Fulking Parish Council, who have raised concerns that vehicles travelling at inappropriate speeds on Clappers Lane, which is frequently used by cyclists and equestrians. Clappers Lane is particularly narrow, leaving vulnerable road users little option to move out of the way of vehicles travelling at inappropriate speeds, leading to hazardous conflicts.

The request for a lower speed limit has been assessed against the West Sussex County Council speed limit policy. Under the criteria of this policy it is considered that a 30 MPH speed limit would be suitable for the road.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, numbered MDS2309 shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (FULKING: CLAPPERS LANE) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Fulking: Clappers Lane) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023"
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Paragraph 2 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –

(a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and

- (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
