WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (OVING: TANGMERE ROAD) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to extend the 40mph speed limit on Tangmere Road east of Drayton Lane eastwards 1.67km to Tangmere village

The section of Tangmere Road east of Drayton Lane is currently de-restricted and subject to a 60mph speed limit. The Parish Council and local community have raised concerns about the speed of vehicles entering the village and requested the 40mph speed limit be extended.

The route has been assessed as being suitable for a 40mph speed limit on the approach to Tangmere village. The reduced speed limit aims to provide sufficient slowing down distance for drivers approaching the sharp lefthand bend. Additionally, a new bus stop has been located on the road increasing the numbers of vulnerable road users.

This Order is proposed so as to reduce danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the safe passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Drawing CHI2309 Oving – Tangmere Road proposed speed limits (30.11.2023) shows the length of road, which is the subject of the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (OVING: TANGMERE ROAD) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the x day of x 202* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Oving: Tangmere Road) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*"
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
- 3. Nothing in Paragraph 2 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
