

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(FERNHURST: PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY No. 1296)**  
**(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER No. 2 2023**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that West Sussex County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Bridleway No. 1296 Fernhurst, from its eastern end at its junction with Restricted Byway No. 2003 (SU904301), westwards for a distance of 145 metres (SU902301).

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst construction works are undertaken on adjacent land.

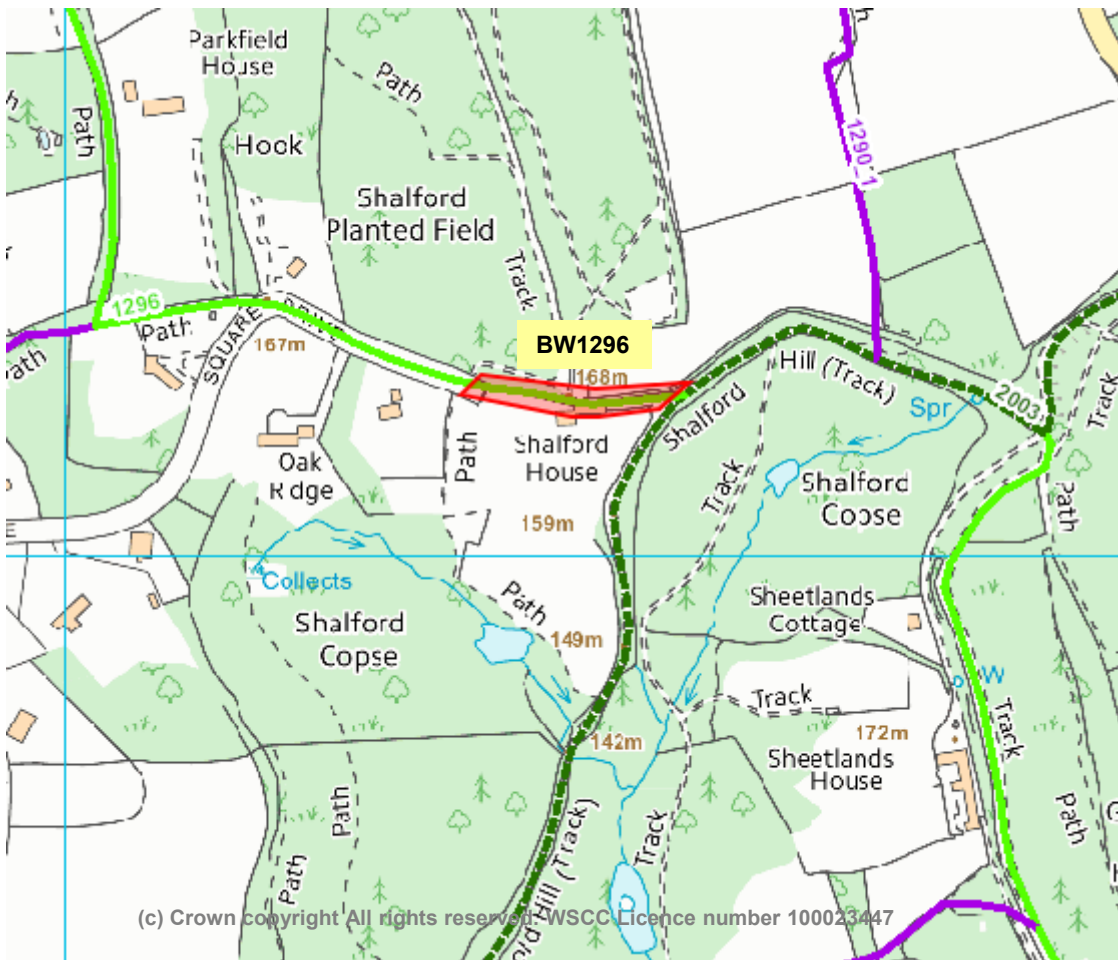
Unfortunately, there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network but an alternative route will be provided.

The Order will come into effect on 14 December 2023 and will last for 6 months or until the Public Bridleway is safe to reopen whichever is sooner.
