NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to amend parking restrictions on lengths of roads in Haywards Heath as follows:

Augustines Way: to prohibit waiting at any time (Introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of the road at its junction with Pineham Copse. **Hoblands:** to make short adjustments to the length of other existing lengths of double yellow line in the road and adjust the order to match existing restrictions. **Manaton Close:** to install double yellow lines at the entrance to the northern garage compound. **Syresham Gardens:** to remove a section of single yellow line opposite its junction with Caxton Way.

The Order also adjusts the Order enacting parking restrictions in Woodridge Close and Vale Road to match the existing restrictions installed on those roads.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will amend parking restrictions on lengths of roads in Haywards Heath as follows:

Augustines Way: to prohibit waiting at any time (Introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of the road at its junction with Pineham Copse. **Hoblands:** to make short adjustments to the length of other existing lengths of double yellow line in the road and adjust the order to match existing restrictions. **Manaton Close:** to install double yellow lines at the entrance to the northern garage compound. **Syresham Gardens:** to remove a section of single yellow line opposite its junction with Caxton Way.

The Order also adjusts the Order enacting parking restrictions in Woodridge Close and Vale Road to match the existing restrictions installed on those roads.

West Sussex County Council received an application for new parking restrictions at the junction of Augustines Way with Pineham Copse. It is reported that vehicles parking at this location obstruct visibility and cause congestion.

While advertising these restrictions, the opportunity is being taken to make other small amendments to restrictions where additional parking can be provided by shortening existing restrictions, or where short lengths of new restriction are needed to resolve local access issues.

In addition, the Order resolves discrepancies between the yellow line markings installed as part of previous schemes in Hoblands and Woodridge Close and the Order enacting the restriction. Updating the order will ensure the existing layout of lines can be enforced in these roads when needed.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to facilitate the passage of traffic.

The table below lists the roads affected by the Order and the drawing numbers on which the proposed changes appear.
