NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the western side of Greystoke Road in Ferring at the entrance to The Glebelands Community Centre and the entrance to Ferring Baptist Church. It is also proposed to prohibit waiting at any time on the eastern side of Greystoke Road/Ferringham Lane at its junction with Church Lane.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the western side of Greystoke Road in Ferring at the entrance to The Glebelands Community Centre and the entrance to Ferring Baptist Church. It is also proposed to prohibit waiting at any time on the eastern side of Greystoke Road/Ferringham Lane at its junction with Church Lane.

Ferring Parish Council have raised concerns that parked vehicles on Greystoke Road are causing obstruction to traffic and reducing visibility for vehicles emerging onto the road from accesses and side roads. On assessing the application, it was agreed this problem could be improved by the installation of double yellow lines to improve visibility at the most affected junctions. These measures will also be beneficial in providing safe places for vehicles travelling in opposite directions to pass each other.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to facilitate the passage of traffic.

The attached drawings, numbered Q0902NWN and TQ0902NWS show the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.






