West Sussex County Council (Aldingbourne: Hook Lane) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2024

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce a 30 MPH speed limit throughout the entire length of Hook Lane in Aldingbourne.

Hook Lane is a narrow road which has bends with limited visibility, several accesses to residential and agricultural premises and no footways. It presently has a 30 MPH speed limit at the eastern end of the road, but the remaining section is de-restricted. An application has been received to extend the 30 MPH speed limit throughout the whole road due to concerns about the safety of vulnerable road users such as pedestrians and cyclists. The road has been reviewed against the criteria of the recently revised West Sussex County Council Speed Limit Policy and found to be compliant with a 30 MPH speed limit throughout its entire length.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, numbered ARN2305 shows the length of road affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (ALDINGBOURNE: HOOK LANE) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Aldingbourne: Hook Lane) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2024"
- 2. The Orders Specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
