

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (TRO) CONSULTATION

MDS2401MM – Poynings: Poynings Road & The Street

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West Sussex County Council
(Poynings: Various Roads) (20 MPH and 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 MPH speed limit on the following roads in Poynings:

Poynings Road a) from a point 150m south of its southern junction with Saddlescombe Road, to its junction with The Street; b) from The Street, northwards to a point 65m north of Mill Close

The Street: from Poynings Road to a point 220m west of Dyke Close.

The Order also enacts 20 MPH speed limits throughout the entire lengths of Dyke Close, Dyke Lane, Mill Close and Mill Lane.

The Order also re-enacts a 30 MPH speed limit on Poynings Road from the roundabout at its junction with the A281 to the new 20 MPH speed limit described above.

(Poynings: Various Roads) (20 MPH and 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2024

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce a 20 MPH speed limit on the following roads in Poynings:

Poynings Road a) from a point 150m south of its southern junction with Saddlescombe Road, to its junction with The Street; b) from The Street, northwards to a point 65m north of Mill Close

The Street: from Poynings Road to a point 220m west of Dyke Close.

Poynings Road and The Street are very narrow roads with few footways. Visibility for traffic is very limited due to blind bends and the roads are frequently used by cyclists, equestrians, and walkers. Poynings Parish Council have therefore applied for a 20 MPH speed limit to improve safety on the affected roads. This request has been assessed and found to comply with the criteria for 20 MPH speed limits set by the West Sussex County Council Speed Limit Policy.

The Order also enacts 20 MPH speed limits throughout the entire lengths of Dyke Close, Dyke Lane, Mill Close and Mill Lane. These roads are all cul-de-sacs accessed from Poynings Road or The Street and are included in the Order for consistency and to avoid the need for otherwise unnecessary signage at their junctions.

The Order also re-enacts the 30 MPH speed limit on Poynings Road from the roundabout at its junction with the A281 to the new 20 MPH speed limit described above.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, numbered MDS2401 shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(POYNINGS: VARIOUS ROADS) (20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ***** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Poynings: Various Roads) (20 MPH and 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2024"
2. The Order Specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 or 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

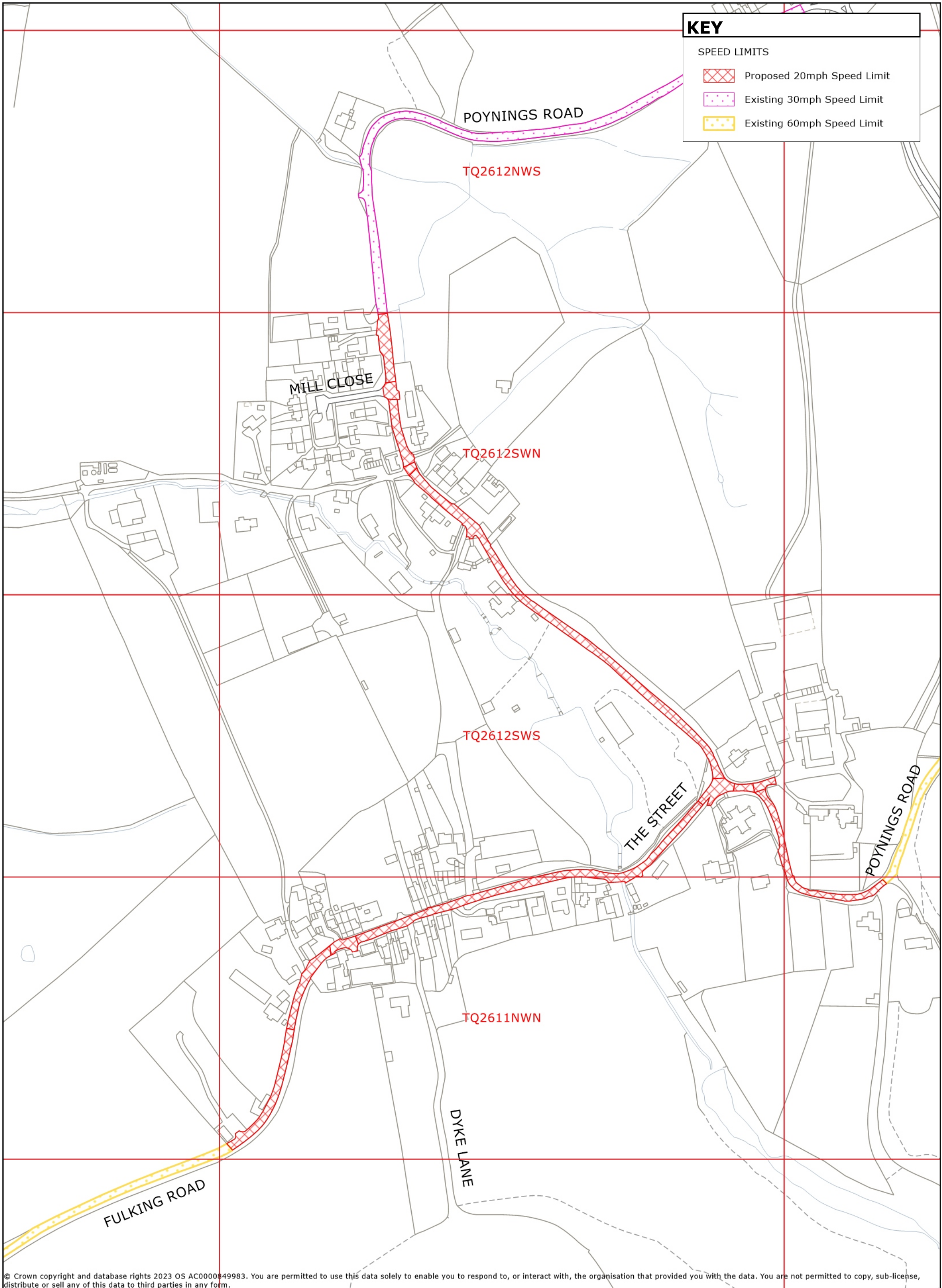


