On-Street Parking Account

In the financial year April 2023 to March 2024 West Sussex County Council received parking income of £4,143,082 against expenditure of £2,753,400 leaving a surplus of £1,389,682 for the year. A breakdown is shown below.

In Adur District, WSSC received parking income of £30,000 against expenditure of £57,690 leaving a deficit of £27,690 for the year.

In Arun District, WSSC received parking income of £419,054 against expenditure of £248,492 leaving a surplus of £170,562 for the year.

In Chichester District, WSSC received parking income of £465,077 against expenditure of £368,369 leaving a surplus of £96,708 for the year.

In Crawley Borough, WSSC received parking income of £220,387 against expenditure of £158,665 leaving a surplus of £61,722 for the year.

In Horsham District, WSSC received parking income of £233,697 against expenditure of £209,271 leaving a surplus of £24,426 for the year.

In Mid Sussex District, WSSC received parking income of £217,315 against expenditure of £215,850 leaving a surplus of £1,465 for the year.

In Worthing Borough, WSSC received parking income of £2,557,042 against expenditure of £1,492,743 leaving a surplus of £1,064,299 for the year.

WSSC also received Countywide parking income of £510 against expenditure of £2,320 leaving a deficit of £1,810.

In West Sussex the District and Borough Councils have been delegated responsibility for the day to day management of the County Councils parking portfolio through Agency Agreements. Details relating to income received from Penalty Charge Notices (on and off-street) may be obtained from the respective District or Borough Council.

Expenditure is made up of the cost of providing the parking portfolio and the development of Controlled Parking Zones.

The surplus will be held and used towards the total cost of providing the County Council's parking service and supporting public transport in future years.

Controlled On-Street Parking Spaces

Seven major controlled parking zones exist in West Sussex which are detailed below together with the number of controlled on street spaces within each zone. These controlled spaces include permit holders only, pay and display and shared use but exclude those with no associated charge such as free limited waiting.

Billingshurst controlled parking zone has 256 spaces

Bognor Regis controlled parking zone has 974 spaces

Chichester controlled parking zone has 3,144 spaces

Crawley controlled parking zone has 2,949 spaces

East Grinstead controlled parking zone has 856 spaces

Horsham controlled parking zone has 2,118 spaces

Worthing controlled parking zone has 5,602 spaces

Overall there are 15,863 spaces.
