**NOTICE** is hereby given that West Sussex County Council propose to make a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a length of prohibition of waiting at all times (double yellow lines) on the north side of Haslett Avenue East at the signalised junction with Hawth Avenue.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER**

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to introduce a permanent Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a length of prohibition of waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on the north side of Haslett Avenue East at the signalised junction with Hawth Avenue.

West Sussex County Council are undertaking a comprehensive refurbishment programme converting halogen traffic signals to LED technology to ensure that the traffic signals are kept in a safe and working condition. LED technology

One of the sites on the programme is the signal controlled junction of Haslett Avenue East and Hawth Avenue. As part of the review and design work it has been identified that some of the carriageway markings need to be altered to being them upto the latest standards. There are also currently no waiting restrictions on the eastbound approach to the junction. To maintain traffic flows through the junction it is proposed to introduce a length of double yellow lines to prohibit waiting at any time.

This Order is proposed for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).




