

# Follow the Clues to Firework Safety...

**1. Never** play with fireworks. They are explosives and can hurt you.

**2. Only** adults should light or hold fireworks.

**3. When** you are watching fireworks, stand well back.

**4. Never** go near a firework that has been lit. Even if it hasn't gone off, it could still explode.

**5. Fireworks** will frighten your pets, so keep them safely indoors.

**6. If** you are given a sparkler:

**Always** wear gloves.

**Hold** it at arm's length.

**When** your sparkler goes out, **DON'T TOUCH IT.** It could still burn you, so put it hot end down in a bucket of water.

**Never** give sparklers to a child under five.

Remember, you have to be **18** years old before you are allowed to buy fireworks in the shops.
