Search for an Address – Option 1

To use the address search:

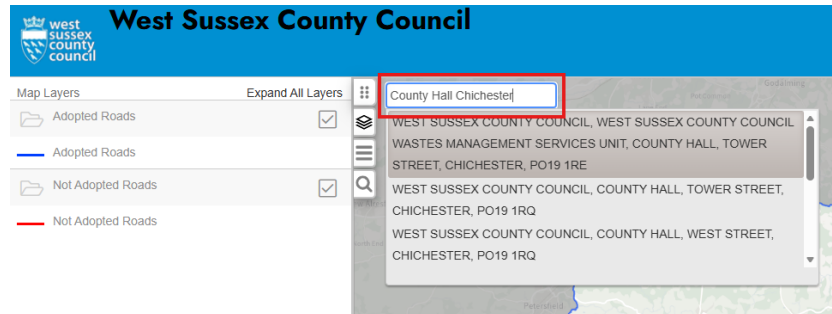


Figure 1: Address Search – Option 1

1. Enter address details in the address search tool on the map pane – results will appear as you type (Highlighted red in Figure 1).

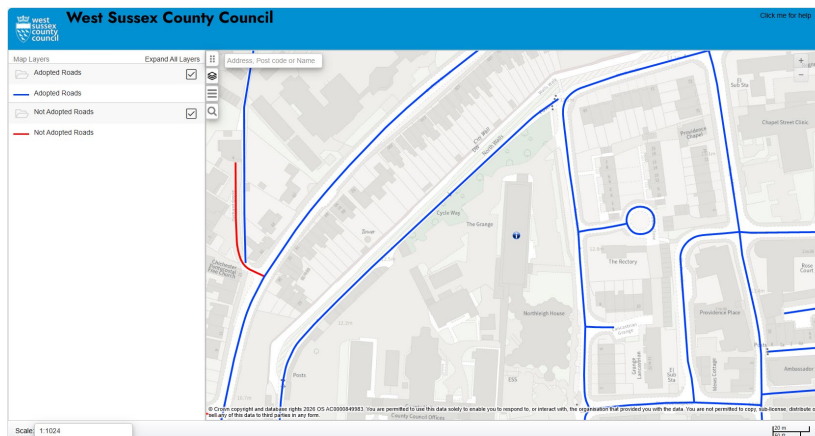


Figure 2: Select an address to zoom to that location

2. Select the required address. The map will zoom to that location (Figure 2).

Search for an Address – Option 2

To use the address search:

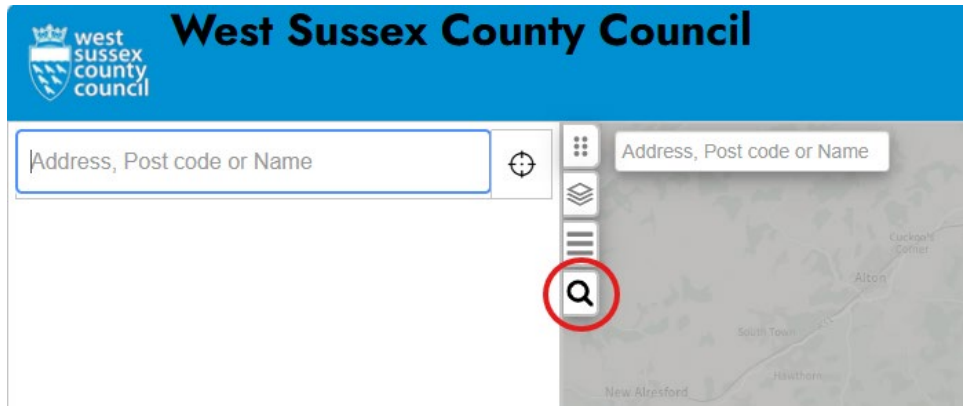


Figure 3: Address Search – Option 2

1. Click the Magnifier (circled red in Figure 3).

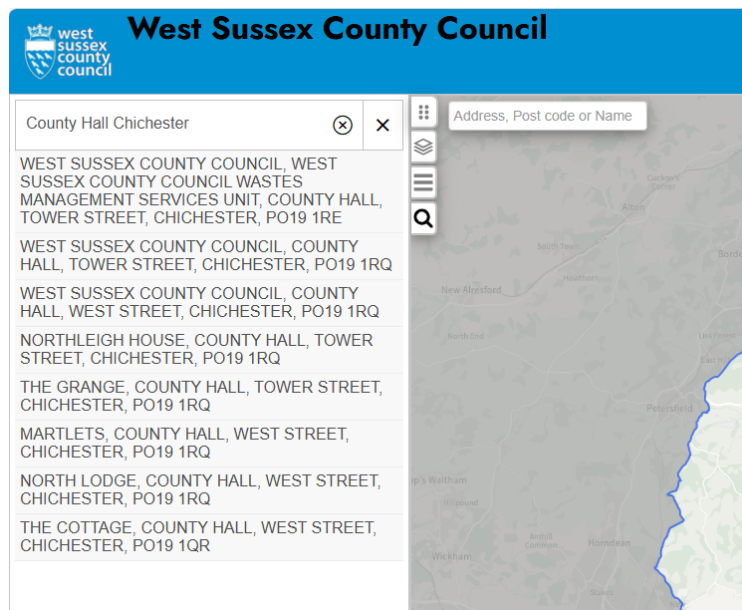


Figure 4: Search results

2. Enter address details – results will appear as you type (Figure 4).

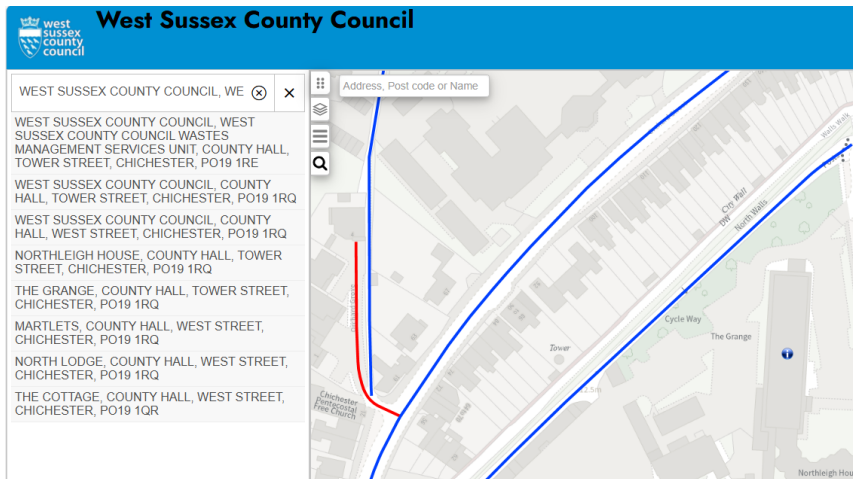


Figure 5: Select an address to zoom to that location

3. Select the required address. The map will zoom to that location (Figure 5).

Find Out whether a Road Is Adopted

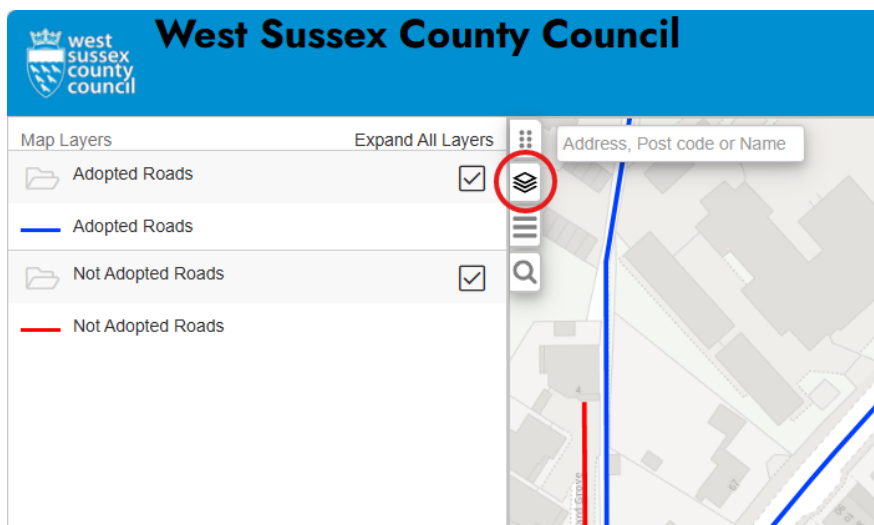


Figure 6: Map Layers

1. Click the Layers tab (circled red in Figure 6) to display the layers available on the map.
2. Refer to the key to find out whether a road is adopted.

Viewing Information about a Road's Status

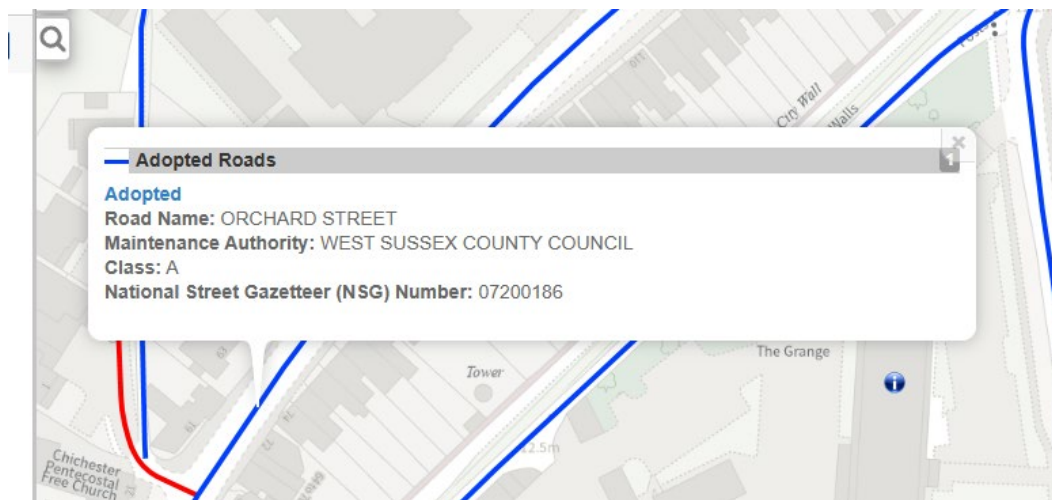


Figure 7: Viewing a road's status information

1. Click a road to display a pop-up box containing information about its status – see Figure 7.
2. Refer to Table 1 for the definition of each road class.
3. To close the pop-up, click the X in its top right corner.

Class	Definition
A	Principal or trunk road
B or C	Non-principal classified road
D	Unclassified road
E	Link footway
G	Green lane (limited maintenance)
M	Motorway
O	Other maintained road (limited maintenance)
P	Private street or private road
Q	Non-maintained road (new estates/private lanes)
R	Gatwick Airport road
T	Public right of way or track (limited maintenance) – part of the road network but not publicly maintainable highway. For public rights of way, this is only a graphical representation of where they are. For details and true definitive legal status, contact the County Council's Public Rights of Way Team on 01243 777620.

Table 1: Definition of Class entries shown on Road Status information

Tips for Using the Map Browser

To **navigate** around the map:

- Click and drag the map.

To **zoom in and out**:

- Click the plus (+) and minus (-) in the top right corner of the map (Figure 8).
- Use the mouse wheel.
