## **IDENTIFIED ISSUES**



Moving schools, colleges, and homes is disruptive.

We shouldn't be expected to fit into a system not built for us.

There's a
difference in
living standards
between foster and
residential care.

The level of support can feel unequal.





Communication between foster carers and social workers needs to improve.

Delays are caused by infrequent updates about visits and moves.



Policies for everyday life in care are unclear.

We need clearer rules for stayovers, sleepovers, and pocket money.



Foster carers need more training and support.

They need help understanding trauma, curfews, and preparing for moves.



We created a video of our experiences and will help develop new training.





cicc is developing a new leaflet for young people to explain the differences.

A working group, including young people, will be set up to address policies.
